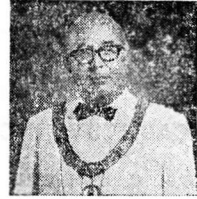

## THE PASSING OF A TRADITION

Our Brother Illustrious Juan Causing, 33°, in his book, *Freemasonry in the Philippines*, on pages 110 through 114, gives an excellent account of the fusion of the Gran Logia Regional [previously under the Grande Oriente Español] with the Grand Lodge of the Philippines, and the Gentleman's Agreement that resulted therefrom during the first election of Grand Lodge Officers on February 13, 1917:

"When news of the death of Ill. Miguel Morayta was received in Manila on January 24, 1917, the Filipino Masons who held him in the highest esteem felt released from their sense of moral obligation and allegiance to the Grande Oriente Español. About the end of January the initial steps towards unification were taken. Wor. Bros. Manuel L. Quezon, Tomas Earnshaw, and Teodoro M. Kalaw representing the Gran Logia Regional and MW Bro. William H. Taylor, Grand Master; and H. Eugene Stafford and Newton C. Comfort, PGMs, representing the Grand Lodge of the Philippine Islands met to discuss terms for the unification. The joint meeting of the two Masonic groups was to be held at one o'clock in the afternoon of February 13, 1917 at the Hotel de France on Plaza Goiti. . . . The Gran Logia Regional ratified the terms of the agreement on February 2, but the members of the Grand Lodge of the Philippines at a meeting the day before the beginning of the Fifth Annual Communication, February 13-14, 1917, turned the terms down. They insisted that the unification be, not by union, but by affiliation of the Filipino Lodges to the Grand Lodge of the Philippine Islands.

"This unexpected turn of affairs nearly ruined all. Besides, a cablegram from Madrid came stating that the Gran Concejo de la Orden (the Executive Council of the Order) approved, subject to ratification by the General Assembly to be held the following June, the conversion of the Gran Logia Regional into the Gran Logia Nacional de Filipinas (National Grand Lodge of the Philippines). This tardy concession was ignored because it came too late for the Lodges to reconsider what has already been decided.

"The question now before the two committees was how to save the situation, to get out of the impasse. All eyes were focused on WB Manuel L. Quezon, Master of Sinukuan Lodge No. 272, the leader of the Filipino participation in the government of the Islands, and a good friend of the Grand Master, MW William H. Taylor. Thanks to the spirit of true brotherhood and the statesmanship of the leaders of both groups, the desired end was attained. The Filipino Masons even at the sacrifice of what they stood for as expressed in the proposed terms they approved, accepted the terms imposed by their American brothers.

"The Grand Master MW William H. Taylor, as a consequence, granted dispensation to 27 Lodges under the supervision of the Gran Logia Regional, according to the priority of their organization under the Grande Oriente Español:

# GOSSIP

Gossip, idle talk, groundless rumor, tattle, are among the many human faults and failings, which travel like a wind-swept fire from ear to ear, and sometimes destroy, without conscience, the good name of a man, the reputation of an institution, or even the pride, confidence and integrity of a nation, or whatever it chooses to blight and wither. To speak abusive words in public, to put libelous statements in print, or to bear false testimony in court, are offenses that can be traced to their source, for which there is due punishment. But let words loose on a whisper which sweeps from ear to ear and from lip to lip, and which suggests more than it says is of all the most despicable bearing of false witness.

Because of our receptiveness to gossip and our eagerness to be the first to tell something, we perhaps involve ourselves in the spread of what is false and unfounded often more than we would wish to admit. There is nothing that cannot be made worse by telling by tattlers and busy bodies. May heaven keep a man and his possessions from the blight of those who whisper at his back. "There is a lust in man no charm can tame of loudly publishing his neighbor's shame; on eagles' wings immortal scandals fly, while virtuous actions are but born and die."

In a day of flagrant oratory and much speech-making, we are reminded that truth usually can be briefly stated, but untruth often requires many words to cover the nature of

its falsity. Perhaps that is why we so often find extended eloquence travelling hand in hand with questionable meanings. The unadorned brevity of truth is always to be preferred to the ornamentation of a lie, no matter how attractive the latter may seem to be, or no matter at what price it is offered. It may be a misleading picture, an academic lecture, a religious dissertation, a document of statesmanship, or merely backdoor whispering, gossip or innuendo — but whatever form it takes, its motive is always questionable, and its practice is always dangerous. It is the tool of demagogues, despots, and designing men. It is the enemy of truth. Propaganda is that which uses or misuses fact for private motive, often with complete disregard for truth. Truth is that which dishonest men seek to refute or distort, and which honest men have no alternative but to accept.

In both private conversation and public declamation it is difficult to know when we are hearing truth, half-truth, or unmodified falsehood. A teacher often censors his information for the ears of his students by placing his own interpretation upon them. The statistician often censors his information by quoting only part of the figures or by giving his particular interpretation to the figures quoted. The public official, likewise, and also the writer of crusading books and pamphlets, and the overzealous promoter of goods and services, and the neighbor who speaks in low and meaningful terms over the back fence is, no doubt, skillful in the art of censoring news

at the source. With so many claims and counterclaims, with so many extravagant representations and so many false accusations, and such a bedlam of conflicting views and contradictory reports, unless a man is wary indeed, he will spend his lifetime on a diet of news censored at the source, and form his opinions and decisions on the basis of false information.

There are persons that play upon the weaknesses of men and promise us fabulous things if, to realize them, we will but permit ourselves to be enslaved for the moment. They lust for power and cloak their lust with the deception of pretending to serve those whom they would lead to bondage. They vend sensationalism, gossip, and they make capital out of the misfortunes of men. They promise something for nothing, they promise us brotherhood and peace and plenty at bargain prices, with short cuts to all good things.

Our civilization has courts of law to pronounce judgement upon the thief who takes another man's tangible property, and prisons for the punishment of them who are careless with other people's goods. It is regrettable, however, that it is more difficult to bring to justice those who defame another person's character or traffic carelessly with another man's good name. Whispering pointed suggestions, innuendo — they who use them to undermine their fellow men are infinitely more despicable than the prowling thief or marauding robber, because they take that which cannot possibly benefit anyone and can never be replaced.

There is a type of usurpation of the function of justice which is of long-standing and universal, that is the judgement which individuals and groups of men and women pre-

sume to pronounce upon the character and qualifications of their fellow men — with whispered testimony — cowardly, self appointed tribunals that accuse, try, and condemn a man without his ever having known of it. Because of real or imagined slight, or personal prejudice, or envy, or because of the sheer malicious pleasure of gossiping, who are given to destroying the peace and effectiveness and reputation of others. The fact is that if we are looking for it, we can find offense against *any* man, because perfection in the human race is conspicuous by its absence.

We can do harm to the standing of any man in the estimation of others by minimizing his virtues and magnifying his faults, or we can build up any man in the minds of others by magnifying his virtues and minimizing his faults. But the reverse is the function of the scandal-mongers and the gossips — to ignore the real and genuine and fine things about life and people, and to cast a glare on blemishes. In the eyes of a jealous or malicious observer, anyone may be judged unfit for the thing he is doing or may propose to do.

It is not improbable that people who are loose in their judgment of others are the instigators of more sorrow, more mischief, and more waste in human lives than wars, famines, and pestilence, because there is not any home or any country or any heart that is proof against them. "Judge not, that ye not be judged". To sit in the judgment seat upon our fellow men with malicious and harmful intent or with careless and thoughtless indifference is a flagrant usurpation of judicial function. It is a major offense against humanity, and those who indulge in it will surely reap as they have sown.

# THE 57th ANNUAL GRAND COMMUNICATION

The 57th Annual Communication of the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of the Philippines was held April 26-28, 1973 at the Jose Abad Santos Hall of the Plaridel Masonic Temple, Manila.

In the morning of the 25th, a Golf Tournament was held at the Camp Aguinaldo Greens.

The Grand Master's Dinner was held at the Stafford Hall of the Scottish Rite Temple. In the evening of the same day, Past Master, Grand Officers, District Deputy Grand Master, District Grand Lecturers, Grand Lodges Inspectors, dignitaries and delegates from overseas, ladies and other guest were in Attendance.

Thropies for the winners in the golf tourney were awarded by WB Domingo C. Bascara, chairman of the tournament. Certificates of appreciation were also distributed by the Grand Master, William C. Council.

At 8:45 the next day, floral offers were made at the statues of Bros. Jose Rizal, Graciano Lopez Jaena and Marcelo H. del Pilar at the foyer of the Temple.

The Grand Master laid the wreath for Bro. Rizal, MW Theodore Way, Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of China made the offering to Graciano Lopez Jaena while RW John O. Wallace laid the flowers for Marcelo H. del Pilar.

The Depty Grand Master assisted by the Grand Officers opened the Grand Lodges of the Philippines for the purpose of holding the An-

nual Communication at 9:00 A.M. promptly.

After the Grand Master was received with Grand Honors, he presided over the reception of the other dignitaries and the communication proper.

MW Frederick Kasuwagi, Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Japan was the Guest Speaker for the Communications.

The highlight of the second day of the communication was the election of the Grand Officers.

With the election of RW Jose L. Araneta as Junior Grand Warden, a Fifty year old tradition of the Grand Lodge was broken. For the first time in fifty years, a Filipino was elected instead of a Caucasian, thus breaking the tradition of alternating the Stewardship of the Grand Lodge between a Filipino and a Caucasian.

In the afternoon of the third day, the overseas brethren and provincial brethren and ladies were treated to a sight-seeing tour around Manila. WB Ernesto Z. Gonzales was the tour Director. Among the places visited were Rizal Park, Fort Santiago, Nayon Pilipino and the American Memorial Cemetery.

In the evening, the officers of the Grand Lodge was installed into office with MW Manuel M. Crudo, PGM, as the Installing Officer and MW Damaso C. Tria, PGM as Master of Ceremonies.

The Development Bank of the Philippines Chorale assisted with the musical numbers. Mrs. Althea

Z. Galicia also rendered several musical numbers. Jose Alvarez of Radio-TV fame was also on hand for several numbers.

MW Raymond E. Wilmarth, PGM, presented the Past Grand Master's Jewel to MW William C. Councill immediate Past Grand Master.

The Grand Master's Cup was presented to Shangrila Lodge No. 196 by MW William H. Quasha. WB Desiderio Dalisay received the trophy for the Lodge.

WB Dalisay was also presented with Jose Abad Santos medal for exemplary Masonic Services to the Fraternity.

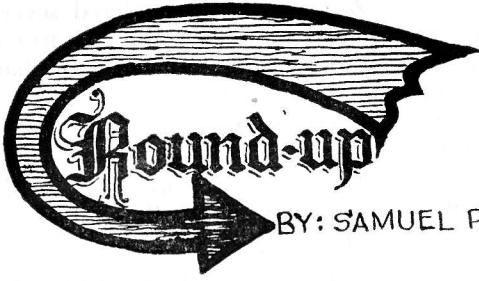
Diplomas of Merit were also awarded to deserving Brethren.

of Arts degree holder. He is married to the former Zenaida Lapuz and has four healthy children: Marvi, Fernando, Mary Jane, and Dennis.

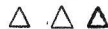
WB Reyes is a Master of the Royal Secret, Luzon Bodies, and a member of Kalaw Chapter No. 9, O.E.S.

# ON MASONIC EDUCATION

245. *Why are there only three degrees in the Blue or symbolic Masonry.*

There are only three degrees in Blue or symbolic Masonry in allusion to the three principal stages in human life — youth, manhood, and age. In youth as an Entered Apprentice his education is principally moral; in manhood as a Fellow Craft, intellectual; and in age as a Master Mason, spiritual.

246. *Is it true that Freemasonry teaches evolution?*

Freemasonry teaches evolution. In the ceremonies where the Lodge prays for the candidate *natural or physical evolution* is symbolized. This is the evolution of the race irrespective of the individual. In those in which the candidate is told to pray for himself *spiritual evolution* is symbolized. This is the evolution which each individual must undergo for himself alone.

247. *What two Grand Lodges owe their organization to the Grand Lodge of the Philippines?*

The two Grand Lodges which owe their organization to the Grand Lodge of the Philippines are the Grand Lodge of China, organized on March 18, 1949, and the Grand Lodge of Japan, organized on March 17, 1957.

248. *In what way is the triangle a proper symbol for man?*

The triangle is a proper symbol for man because it is the first geometric figure enclosed by three straight lines and man is endowed with three attributes: body, mind, and soul. Man as the product of *natural or physical evolution* is represented by the *right-angled triangle*: the base representing his body, the altitude his mind, and the hypotenuse his spirit. Man as the product of *spiritual evolution* is represented by the *equilateral triangle*.

249. *Is Scottish Freemasonry the same as the Scottish Rite?*

Scottish Freemasonry is *not* the same as the Scottish Rite. Scottish Freemasonry refers to the system of Masonry practiced in Scotland. While the Scottish Rite refers to the branch of Masonry which consists of 33 degrees governed by a Supreme Council and whose official title is the *Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry*.

250. *In Freemasonry are the words secrets and mysteries synonymous?*

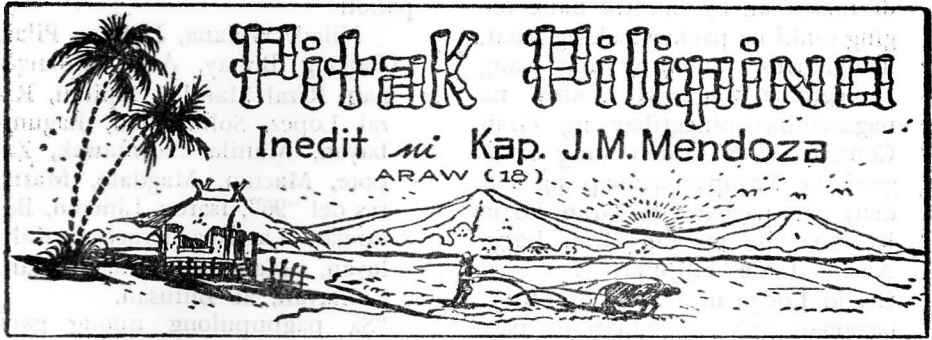
The words *secrets* and *mysteries* are not synonymous in Freemasonry. The modes of recognition and the ceremonies of initiation are secrets which can only be known to those entitled to them because of previous initiation. The Hiramic Legend and the Search for that which was lost are mysteries which remain secret to those who do not have the patience, mental capacity, or desire to know their meaning.

251. *How did the ancients regard the sun?*

The common mass of the ancients regarded the sun as a god, the more enlightened few, particularly those initiated in the Ancient Mysteries, regarded it as merely a symbol of GOD.

252. *What two things are peculiar to Freemasonry?*

Two things peculiar to Freemasonry are: (1) It does NOT invite any person to join the Order, he must come of his own free will and accord; (2) It teaches its doctrine by "allegory, illustrated by symbols".

Ang Ating Kapatid na Tanyag Juan Causing, 33°, sa kaniyang aklat na FREEMASONRY IN THE PHILIPPINES, sa mga pahinang 110 hanggang 114 ay nagbigay ng isang napakahusay na ulat ukol sa pagsanib ng Gran Logia Regional (dating nasa ilalim ng Grande Oriente Español) sa Kataastaasang Lohiya ng Pilipinas, at sa Kasunduang Maginoo na kinahantungan ng nasa-bing pagsanib, nang unang paghahalal sa mga Opisyal ng Kataastasang Lohiya nuong ika-13 ng Pebrero 1917:

“Nang mapabalita sa Maynila ang pagkamatay ni Tanyag Miguel Morayta nuong ika-24 ng Enero 1917, ang mga Pilipinong Mason na may pagtatangi sa kaniya ay nakadama ng paglaya sa damdamin nilang moral na pananagutan at pagkamatapat sa Grande Oriente Español. Sa pagtatapos ng Enero, ang unang mga hakbanging tungo sa pagkakaisa ay naisagawa. Ang Marangal na Mga Kapatid Manuel L. Quezon, Tomas Earnshaw, at Teodoro M. Kalaw na kumakatawan sa Gran

Lohiya Regional; at ang Karangal-dangalang William H. Taylor, Kataastaasang Guro, at H. Eugene Stafford at Newton Comfort, Dating Mga Kataastaasang Guro, na kumakatawan sa Kataastaasang Lohiya ng Pilipinas ay nagpanayam upang talakayin ang mga itatadhana sa pag-iisa. Ang magkasanib na pulong ng dalawang pangkat ng mga Mason ay nakatakdang idaos sa ganap na ika-1 ng hapon nuong ika-13 ng Pebrero 1917, sa Hotel de France sa Plaza Goiti... Ang Gran Logia Regional ay nagpatibay sa itinadhana ng kasunduan nuong ika-2 ng Pebrero, subalit ang mga kagawad ng Gran Lohiya ng Pilipinas ay tinanggihan ang gayong mga tadhana sa kanilang pulong nuong bisperas ng pagsisimula ng ikalimang taunang komunikasyon nang ika-13-14 ng Pebrero 1917. Kanilang iginiit na ang pag-iisa ay isagawa, hindi sa pagbubuklod, kungdi sa pag-anib ng mga Lohiyang Pilipino sa Gran Logia ng Pilipinas.

"Ang pangyayaring ito na hindi inaasahan ay muntik nang naging sanhi ng pagkawasak ng lahat. Tangi rito, dumating ang isang kablegrama mula sa Madrid na nagsasabing pinagtibay ng Gran Consejo de la Orden (ang Sangguniang Tagapagpaganap ng Orden) ang paggawa sa Gran Logia Regional na maging Gran Logia Nacional de Filipinas (National Grand Lodge of the Philippines), bagaman ito'y nasasaklaw ng pagpapatibay ng Pangkalahatang Kapulungan na idaraos sa Hunyong darating. Ang pagparayang ito na nabalam ay winalang halaga sapagka't lubhang huli na upang muling isaalang-alang ng mga Lohiya ang kanilang napagpasyahan.

"Ang suliranin ngayon sa harap ng dalawang lupon ay kung papaanong masasagip ang katatayuan, na makakalasa sa alanganing kalagayan. Lahat na paningin ay napako sa Kagalangalang na Kapatid Manuel L. Quezon, ang Guro ng Lohiyang Sinukuan Blg. 272, na siyang lider ng mga Pilipino sa pamahalaan ng Kapuluan, at isang matalik na kaibigan ng Kataastaasang Guro, William H. Taylor. Salamat sa diwa ng tapat na pagkakapatiran at sa iwing katalinuhan ng mga lider ng dalawang pangkat, at ang kanilang ninasang hantungan ay natamo. Ang mga Pilipinong Mason, sa kabila ng pagpapakasakit sa kanilang paninindigang isinaad sa panukalang kasunduang napagtibay na, ay tinanggap na rin nila ang mga tadhanang ipinagpilitan sa kanila ng mga Amerikano.

"Humantong ito sa pagpapahintulot ng Kataastaasang Guro William H. Taylor sa 27 mga Lohiya na nasa ilalim ng pagmamahisid ng Gran Logia Regional, alinsunod sa pagkakatatag ng mga ito

sa ilalim ng Grande Oriente Español:

Nilad, Walana, Dalisay, Pilar, Bagong Buhay, Araw, Silangan, Rizal Manila, Dapitan, Rizal Lopez, Solidaridad, Bagumbayan, Manila Balintawak, Zapote, Mactan, Magdalo, Martires del "96", Isarog, Lincoln, Batangas, La Regeneracion. Kalilayan, Malinaw, Pinagsabitan, Kalilayan, at Bulusan.

"Sa pagpupulong nuong gabing unang araw ng ika-limang taunang komunikasyon, ika-12 ng Pebrero 1917, ang Lupon sa Mga Karta sa ilalim ng pangungulo ni Kgg. Kap. Charles Gallagher, Guro ng Lohiyang Bagumbayan Blg. 4, ay nagrekomenda na ipagkaloob ang palagiang Karta sa Lohiyang Biak-na-Bato Blg. 7, Lohiyang Cosmos Blg. 8, Lohiyang Saint John Blg. 9, Lohiyang Far East Blg. 10, at Lohiyang Iloilo Blg. 11. Inirekomenda rin na ang 27 na mga Lohiyang gumagamit ng wikang Kastila ay pagkalooban ng palagiang Karta, at ibilang ng sunud-sunod: Nilad Blg. 12, at patuloy hanggang Bulusan na ang bilang ay 36.

"Ang halalalan sa pamunuan ng Kataastaasang Lohiya ay isinunod. Sang-ayon sa liham na may petsa Enero 9, 1961 na tinanggap mula kay Karangaldangalang William H. Taylor na nanungkulang dalawang panahon, ang kinahinatnan ng halalalan ukol sa Kataastaasang Guro ay ang sumusunod:

"... Napagkasunduan na si Quezon ang gagawing Kataastaasang Guro at ang mga Lohiyang Amerikano na nangunguna sa talaan (1 hanggang 11) ay nagdeklara ng kanilang balota para kay Quezon. Nang bumoto na ang mga Pilipino ay saka lamang nila nagunita na kani-

la palang isinusuko na ang Kataastaasang Lohiyang Amerikano sa mga ito (Pilipino), kaya sinimulan nilang bumoto sa akin at sa dakong huli ay ibinoto nilang ang halalan ay lubos na nagkakaisa para sa akin. Sa pagpapatuloy ng halalan, ang Dating Kataastaasang Guro (Hukom) Harvey na nakaupo sa Silangan sa aking gawing kanan, nang tanungin ko kung ano ang aking nararapat gawin ay nagsabing wala akong magagawa kung hindi ang tanggapin (ang pagkakahalal sa akin). Nang itanong ko ito kay Quezon, ang wika niya'y ikaw ang ibig ng mga Pilipino at ganyan na iyan, nguni't ako ang hahaliling manunungkulan sa susunod na taon at ipagpapatuloy natin ang salitan (ng Amerikano at Pilipino), at habang ikaw at ako ay nabubuhay, ang Kasunduang Maginoo na ito ay iingatan ng mga Pilipino.

"Dahil diyan, ang ika-13 ng Pebrero 1917 ay napakadakilang araw sa kasaysayan ng Masoneriya sa Pilipinas. Ito ang araw nang, sa laot ng tunay na diwa ng pagkakapatiran at kasiglahan, ang isa't-isa ay nagsaya at nanaghili sa bawat isa sa kanilang maalab na debosyon at katapatan sa Kapatiran, sa tulong, sa impluwensiya, kakayahan, at katalinuhan ng Kgg Manuel L. Quezon na noon ay Pangulo ng Senado ng Pilipinas, at sa iba pang mga lider ng mga Mason sa dalawang panig, ang dalawang Kataastaasang Samahan ng mga Mason ay buong kasiglahang pinagsama at naging iisang KATAASTAASANG LOHIYA NG MGA MALAYA AT TINANGGAP NA MGA MASON SA KAPULUAN NG PILIPINAS. Ang pinakamamahal natin na Da-

ting Kataastaasang Guro at Pangulo ng Komonwelt ng Pilipinas Manuel L. Quezon ang nauna sa dalawang panig ng Kasunduang Maginoo na sumakabilang-buhay. Umakyat siya sa Kataastaasang Makalangit na Lohiya nuong ika-1 ng Agosto 1944. Ang Kataastaasang Guro William H. Taylor ay nabuhay hanggang nuong ika-25 ng Nobiyembre 1961. Alinsunod sa itinakda ng Kasunduang Maginoo tulad ng ipinahayag ni Karangaldangalang William H. Taylor, ito'y nagwakas na.

Gayunman, ang pag-ibig kapatid na namagitan sa mga magkakapatid na Pilipino at Amerikano sa Kataastaasang Lohiya ay lipos ng init at tibay, kaya't ito'y nagtagal pang nagpapatuloy pagkaraan ng opisyal na pagwawakas nito. Sa tuwi-tuwi na ay paulit-ulit na sumusulpot ang katanungan na kung kailan magagawa na ang kahangahangang kinaugaliang ito ay ibinbin na lamang sa alala ng lumipas, at isang bagong panahon ang ipasinaya na kung saan walang iiral na alituntunin sa paghahalal ng Kataastaasang Guro maliban sa iniaatas ng mga pangaral at kinaugalian ng Malayang Mason.

Limampu-at-anim nang taon na ang kinaugaliang ito na sinimulan nina Karangaldangalang Manuel L. Quezon at Karangaldangalang William H. Taylor nuong ika-13 ng Enero 1917 ay ipinagbunyi at iginalang. Nang ika-13 ng Pebrero 1973, sa pulong na tinawag ni Karangaldangalang William C. Council, Kataastaasang Guro, batay sa Pangkat V. Talatang 4 ng Saligang Batas ng Kataastaasang Lohiya, ang mga Dating Kataastaasang Bantay (Grand Junior Warden) na hindi isasaalang-alang ang kanilang lahi o bansa.

Bagaman, ang nangaroon sa kasalukuyang hanay ay magpapatuloy sa pagsasalitan sa taong kagyat, ang ha-

Nilad, Walana, Dalisay, Pilar, Sinukuan, Bagong Buhay, Araw, Silanganan, Rizal Lopez, Dapitan, Rizal Manila, Solidaridad, Bagumbayan Manila Balintawak, Zapote, Mactan, Magdalo, Martires del "96", Isarog, Lincoln, Batangas, La Regeneracion, Kalilayan, and Bulusan.

"In the evening session on the first day of the Fifth Annual Communication, Feb. 13, 1917, the Committee on Charters under the chairmanship of WB Charles Gallagher. Master of Bagumbayan Lodge No. 4, recommended that permanent charters be granted to Biak-na-Bato Lodge No. 7, Cosmos Lodge No. 8, Saint John's Lodge No. 9, Far East Lodge No. 10, and Iloilo Lodge No. 11. It was also recommended that the 27 Spanish-speaking Lodges be granted permanent charters and numbered consecutively, Nilad Lodge No. 12 and so on, Bulusan Lodge being No. 38.

"The election of Grand Lodge officers followed. According to a letter dated January 9, 1961, received from MW William H. Taylor who served two full terms, the result of the election of Grand Master was the following:

" . . . It had been agreed that Quezon would be the first Grand Master and the American Lodges, coming first on the list (1 to 11 inclusive) declared their ballots for Quezon. It was only when the Filipinos came to vote did they recognize we were surrendering the American Grand Lodge to them, then they began casting their ballots for me and they finally voted to make the election unanimous. As the voting progressed, Past Grand Master (Judge) Harvey who sat in the East on my right, when I asked him what I should do, said I could do nothing but accept. When I asked Quezon about it, he said, The Filipinos wanted you and that's that, but I will take over next year and from then on we will alternate (American and Filipino), and so long as you and I live this Gentleman's Agreement will be kept by the Filipinos."

Thus, February 13, 1917, is a very memorable day in the history of Philippine Masonry. It was the day when, amidst the spirit of true brotherhood and enthusiasm, each jubilant and jealous with each other in their fervent devotion and dedication to the Fraternity, with the help, influence, ability and tact of the Hon. Manuel L. Quezon, then President of the Philippine Senate, and other Masonic leaders of both sides, the two Grand Masonic Bodies happily merged together in to one as the **GRAND LODGE OF FREE AND ACCEPTED MASONS OF THE PHILIPPINE ISLANDS.**"

Our dearly beloved Past Grand Master and President of the Republic of the Philippines, Manuel L. Quezon, was the first of the two parties to the "Gentleman's Agreement" to pass away. He ascended to the Celestial Grand Lodge on August 1, 1944. M.W. William H. Taylor lived until November 25, 1965. According to the terms of the "Gentleman's Agreement" as expressed by M.W. William H. Taylor, it then officially ended.

However, the brotherly love between the Filipino and American brethren in this Grand Lodge was so warm and binding, that it continued long after

its official termination. Time and again the question has arisen as to when this wonderful tradition should be relegated to memories of the past and a new era ushered in where no guidelines would exist for the election of a Grand Master, except those dictated by the tenets and traditions of Freemasonry.

Fifty-six years to a day, the tradition initiated by M.W. Manuel L. Quezon and M.W. William H. Taylor on February 13, 1917, was honored and respected. On February 13, 1973, at the meeting called by M.W. William C. Council, Grand Master, in accordance with Article V. Paragraph 4, Constitution of the Grand Lodge F. & A.M. of the Philippines, the Past Grand Masters present decided to nominate candidates for the Office of Junior Grand Warden without regard to nationality.

While those who are presently in the line will continue the alternation in the immediate years to come, the election of the Junior Grand Warden during the coming Annual Communication will be irrespective of nationality and strictly in accord with Masonic tradition.
