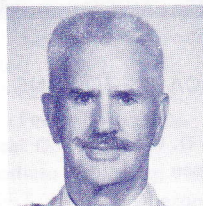

“By the kindness and fellowship I felt at a Masonic dinner.”


“I was impressed by the life of one I knew to be a Mason.”

MASONIC GROWTH

Just after our Annual Communication in 1974, MW John O. Wallace appointed a Committee on Masonic Growth. It had a number of serious and important conferences during which many new areas of approach were explored. The report of the Committee will be the basis for action to be taken in the Symbolic Lodges.

In the interim, while the Masonic Growth Program is being developed it is important that each of us "focus in" on what we mean by Masonic Growth. Actually, the word growth tends to imply increasing the number of Masons. If we hold close to that concept, we shall not be too far from the intended goal. On the other hand, if we think it means increasing membership, we may be a long way off target. Masonic Growth means increasing the number of "dyed-in-the-wool", dedicated Masons and all that goes along with it.

Back a few years ago, in 1969, a young dedicated Mason by the name of Allen E. Roberts wrote a book entitled, "Key to Freemasonry's Growth". To many, this is considered the most enlightened works in the field of Masonic leadership. If you have a copy, read it and reread it. If you don't have a copy, borrow or buy one. And if you can't borrow or buy one, read the copy in the Grand Lodge Library.

It has so many wonderful ideas expressed with such clarity and force, no Masonic reader can escape its influence. He has really put a tag on the two most diametrically opposed forms of leadership. He refers to leaders as (1) *Constructive Leaders* and (2) *Obstructive Leaders*. The first we need badly, the second we can do without.

He doesn't have any sure-fire cure for apathy, indifference, and selfishness, but he does stir up a lot of provocative thinking. Perhaps the best way his work can be summed up in a few words is we must emphasize the *quality* and let quantity take care of itself naturally when men find Masonry is not easy to come by, but is for the few who deserve it by the manner in which they make Masonry their way of life.

The purpose of Masonry is to change men to fit Masonry — not to change Masonry to fit men.

HOW SHOULD MASONS MEET?

The closing ceremony of the Lodge will be incomplete without the above query being propounded by the Worshipful Master, to consistently remind the brethren, that, Masons "meet on the Level". Masonically, the Level is the simplest and noblest symbol of equality and is one of the principal jewels of the Lodge, assigned to the Senior Warden. When we, speak of Masons meeting on the Level, we accurately portray by means of symbolism that we are all equal to one another.

The phrase "on the Level", however, as we oftenly hear today, have gone out and far from the Lodge and is now commonly used in describing: business deals which are being carried out honestly and squarely; men who are sincere, honest and whose actuations are above suspicion; and the mental attitude of people with balanced poise, without reproach, peace-loving and of strong conviction.

Inside the Lodge, there is no better demonstration of the principle of equality among the brethren, than before the Altar of obligation, where all, with bowed heads, pray together in unison, orally or mentally, in the most perfect and most beautiful expres-

sion of oneness, whether he be poor or rich; noble or humble citizen, regardless of one's creed, occupation and station in life. Before the Masonic Altar, all are equal, for there is absolute freedom of faith; where they recite one common prayer acceptable to all creeds; where there is mutual respect for one's belief, setting aside all differences of social status, rank and affluence and concerning themselves only with the highest interest of promoting the common good for all. Here is the place where the humblest brother is regarded as an equal of any other brother, no matter what his fortune or misfortune in life may have been. And, here is the place where every brother salutes the Master of the Lodge — be he the father or grand father of the latter; here, a General of the Army salutes a Lieutenant or a Sergeant, when required by the situation — a perfect example of true democracy in action, not to be found in any other place, except it be in a Masonic Lodge.

Before the Ever Seeing Eye, all men are equal. "All receive equally and impartially the blessing of Eternal Love, even the sun shines and the rain falls on all with equal benediction". The Book of the

Law, likewise, have taught us that we all came from the same dust and that while on temporary sojourn on this mother earth, we are equally traveling upon the level of time, till we return to the dust whence we came from.

Outside the Lodge, we find satisfaction in being equal before the laws of the land, which we are strictly enjoined to observe and obey in our daily lives, as citizens of our Republic. By it, we are enabled to enjoy our inalienable right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, as guaranteed by our Constitution, requiring, however, due respect and corresponding regard for the rights of others — seeing to it that they are not unduly jeopardized or trampled upon, while enjoying those inalienable rights. Under our democratic system of government, each man has an equal right to the full use and development of his mental faculties and other God-given capabilities, without unlawful and premeditated intrusion by others.

It was during the stone age, perhaps, when people were naked, when popular education was yet unknown and ignorance and superstition prevailed, that men, we may consider, were created equal, except in physical size, strength and appearance. But as civilization continually progresses, up to the point when man has been able to conquer space and had set his feet on another planet; when he has become so scientifically advanced as to be able to produce lethal weapons

in warfare and contrived devices capable of exterminating humanity on the surface of the earth, to include the historian supposed to record the occurrence of the anticipated human catastrophe; when he, sitting comfortably on his living room home at can witness a Miss Universe Contest abroad or a World Boxing Championship bout anywhere in the world, men, as a direct consequence of such tremendously unparalleled progress, have, by the own clever ingenuity, ceased to be equal.

If we will interpret the realities of our present social complex, we can readily see that no two men are equal. Men differ from one another as variedly as the physical features, which either adorn or deface the surface of the earth — the hills and the valleys, the forests and the deserts, and seas, and the mountains and numberless others. As a matter of fact, no two men have exactly identical appearance, even if they are twins; they have very unequal physical prowess and mental ability; some are geniuses while others are ignorant; some are born athletes while others can not even walk; some are born orators while others are mute. To speak of equality while the above cases intrigue us, is definitely idle talk. Fortunately for us, by way of consolation, these inequalities that prevail among men of various races and callings, make our life existence more interesting. If men were all the same in all aspects — appearance, size, behavior and ability, we can

readily imagine how dull and monotonous life in this world would be; we can readily imagine the confusion, the frustration and embarrassment that will ensue between husbands and wives is not being able to distinguish one person from another; and there would be no leader and no followers – reducing our collective status to a mere herd of beasts of the same breed, wandering aimlessly over the vast continent of uncertainty.

Inside the Lodge, therefore, while we meet on the Level, on the accepted principle that one brother is the equal of another, we see to it that we elect our officers, so that they may lead the brethren, who must naturally be the followers. On this basis, equality is not at all lost because every brother has exactly the same right and prerogative to be elected as an officer, and everyone is deemed to be a candidate for office during election time and power and authority of the officer so elected, emanates from the brethren, who elected him to office.

The above concept is truly Masonic. If by an unhappy coincidence, a brother feels that he is not the equal of any other brother, thereby staying aloof from the

others, blame not the brethren, blame not Masonry, for it is everyone's right and privilege according to Masonic tenets, customs and traditions, to be meeting with one another on the same level. On the other hand, should there be any brother, who believes that he towers high above the brethren or any other brother, as the king's palace towers above the poor man's hut, it is for the good of our Order that he either renounce that belief completely without further delay, or voluntarily quit the Lodge, where he does not rightfully belong. Be ever reminded that titles, ranks, honors and worldly possessions are not allowed to pass inward through the portals of Masonry. Brotherly love in the highest order and a burning desire to be of service to God, country, the Lodge and the community are the essential attributes in gaining admission into the Lodge.

Assiduous observance of the Masonic tenets require, that even outside the Lodge except in official duties, which should take precedence, Masons should at all times "meet on the Level", whenever and wherever they congregate, to give substance and sincere meaning to: *the brotherhood of man under the Fatherhood of God.*

HELP FIGHT DRUG ABUSE

REPORT OF MARANAW LODGE NO. 111, F. & A.M.

1974 was a year to remember. It was during this time that Maranaw Lodge No. 11 attained an unprecedented increase in membership. The petitions of 47 aspirants were approved, 42 of whom were initiated, passed and raised during this year. This is the reason for the 31 special meetings. Had the Lodge not met much oftener, there would have been a backlog in the conferral of degree on the candidates. Even at the rate that the Lodge worked, there were 4 Fellowcrafts and 5 entered Apprentice Masons on the Trestle Board at the end of December, 1974.

Most of the newly obligates brothers belong to the Roman Catholics Church; some are Cursilistas; and many from the top ranks of the City and Provincial government officials, captains of Industries and businesses, Deans and other high officials of the Mindanao State University and the Iligan Institute of Technology, professional like law-Technology, professionals like lawyers, dentist and engineers.

Two of the Fellowcrafts of the Lodge, namely, Bro. Dominador L. Padilla and Bro. Valerio Salazar are both Assistant City Fiscals of Iligan City. Bro. Carlos Chua and Bro. Alfredo V. Rausa, both Fellowcrafts, are the Manager of Misamis Mahogany, Inc. and Plant Superintendent, Flora Cement Corporation, respectively.

Bro. Policarpio C. Benitez and Bro. Jesus O. Castro, both Entered Apprentices of the Lodge, are the

assistant Manager, National Steel Corporation and Manager, Manila Banking Corporation, respectively.

Petitioner, Mr. Antonio S. Valera is the Manager of the National Steel Corporation. Whereas, petitioner Larmingo M. Tam is the Assistant Manager of the Mindanao Steel Corporation.

The above names were purposely listed in order to show the quality of membership that Maranaw Lodge has attracted during the year under review.

MASONIC VISITATIONS

Due to the prominence of some of the initiates, groups of Masons from different Lodges in Mindanao and Visayas had requested the honor and privilege of conferring degrees on these candidates.

On May 11, 1975, DDGM VW Valerio V. Rovira and his son WB Valerio I. Rovira, Jr. came all the way from Iloilo City to raise his other son Bro. Voltaire I. Rovira, a prominent practicing Lawyer, to the sublime degree of Master Mason. On the same day, DDGM VW Desiderio Dalisay, Sr., together with a number of distinguished Masons from Davao Lodges were also present during the initiation of Bro. Moises F. Dalisay, Presiding Judge, Courth of First Instance of Lanao del Norte, Branch V. Iligan City. As a matter of fact, it was the son of VW Desiderio Dalisay, Sr. and nephew of the initiate who initiated Bro. Moises F. Dalisay. Again, on July 4, 1974, VW Desiderio Dalisay, Sr. and his group returned to Iligan

City to attend the raising of Bro. Moises F. Dalisay to the sublime degree of Master Mason.

On July 13, 1974, the Worshipful Master and several Masons from Cebu Lodge No. 128 came to Iligan to deliver the Masonic Friendship Cup to Maranaw Lodge No. 111; and raise to the Sublime Degree of Bro. George Alcuizar, an Engineer-Supervisor of National Steel Corporation.

On September 28, 1974, a special team from Panay and Negros Lodges headed by no less than DDGM VW Valerio V. Rovira, came to Iligan City for the purpose of raising Bro. Camilo P. Cabili and Bro. Salvador Ll. Laya. Because both candidates are lawyers, quite a number of the visitors from Panay Negros were practicing lawyers, members of the bench and the prosecutory arm of the government. The group was composed of five (5) couples and 21 Master Masons. And to make the group unique was the fact that an incumbent presiding judge of one of the sala of the Court of First Instance of Iloilo City was with the entourage although he was not a member of the Craft. For the purpose of fostering and enchancing brotherly love and affection, the visitors stayed with the families of Masons of Maranaw Lodge No. 111.

INTER-VISITATION OF LODGES

Inter-visitation of Lodges were made by Maranaw Lodge No. 111 to Mt. Malindang Lodge No. 130, Ozamis City, and Macajalar Lodge

No. 184, Cagayan de Oro City, for the purpose of conferring Masonic degrees and also to foster fellowship.

CHARITY WORK

The Lodge has sponsored and financed the sending of five (5) crippled children to the Masonic Hospital for Crippled Children in Manila.

Heretofore, it was the practice of Maranaw Lodge No. 111 to give during the Christmas season gifts to the children of Masons. This year, this practice was abandoned. Instead, Maranaw Lodge collaborated with the Maranaw Bodies and the Order of the Eastern Star in giving Christmas gifts to more than 200 indigent families coming from the different sections of Iligan City. Each family received a package containing rice, dried fish and canned goods.

The sum of ₱3,200 was contributed by the brethren for the scholarship fund of the poor but deserving students. The biggest contributor was Bro. Quitero Miravite, who gave the sum of ₱2,000.00.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

The Lodge was active in the Boy and Girl Scout Movements. DDGM VW Aniceto B. Belisario has been the head of the Iligan City Boy Scouts Council for more than six consecutive years and many brethren are Chairman of Standing Committees and members of the Executive Board of Iligan City. Mrs. Leni A. Cabili, the wife of Bro. Camilo P. Cabili, City Mayor of Iligan, is the incumbent President of the Girl Scouts of Iligan City. Whereas, Bro. Cabili has been actively supporting these two (2) youth organizations with government funds.

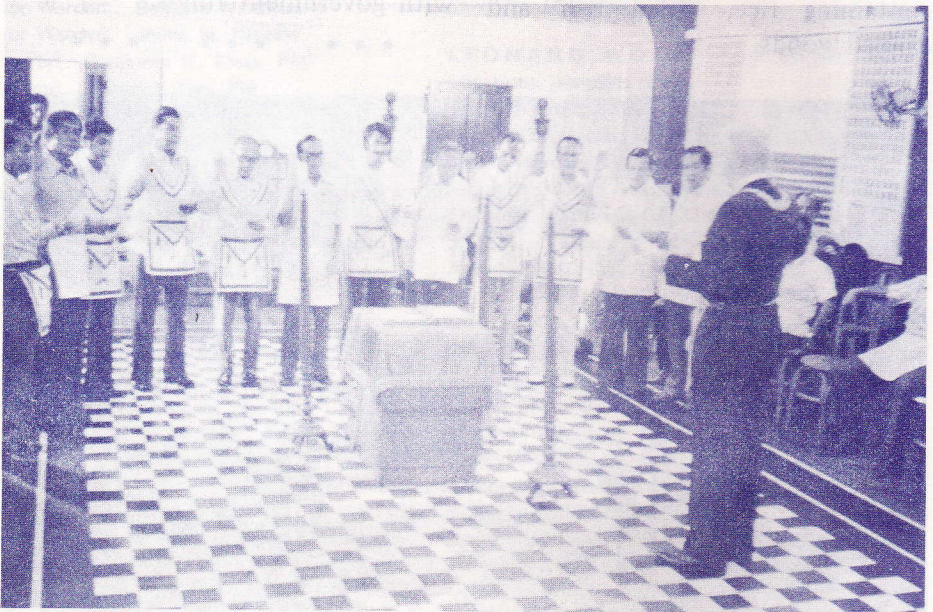

FAULT FINDING

We live in an imperfect world. Everything is flawed and defective. Institutions all blunder and fall short of the ideal. Persons are all erring creatures and their faults give us offense, but one should not pay too much attention to the faults of others, or to the defects of the world in which we live. He may become a chronic fault-finder, and in that case he will become a grumbler. If he is not careful, he will degenerate into a growler. If he growls long enough he will become a cynic. When a man becomes a cynic he has reached the bottom. There is nothing lower than cynicism. A cynic is of no account, either to himself or to anyone else. He is a nuisance and a stumbling block. He did not at the start become a cynic. He began by finding fault and the habit grew on him until his mind became twisted and his heart sour.

Fault-finders are often cruel, sometimes honestly, sometimes for reasons that are other than honest. Sometimes they are right, some-

times they are wrong. But anyone who stands for anything, who does anything that amounts to much, must face the fault-finders — and that requires courage.

Life has its problems for all, its days of discouragement, but much bitterness and heartbreak can be softened by the quality of kindness, which **includes** sincere consideration and which **excludes** cruel and cutting sarcasm, ridicule, and every intent to embarrass, to insult, to degrade.

It is true that we tend to find what we want to find. If it is trouble we are looking for, it is almost certain we shall find it. If we are **looking** for faults, we shall **find** faults. What we see depends much upon what we want to see. There is almost no one with whom we work or live, in whom we could not find much that is good and some things that we might wish were otherwise. And people who live under the same roof, who sit across the same table, can generally magnify faults, much to the sorrow

of all concerned, or, they can concentrate on the finer qualities, even if they fail to find perfection. And we shall sooner find rest in living with people who lack perfection as we learn not to let their imperfections annoy us. Sometimes fault-finding is prompted by jealousy or envy. Sometimes we seek to build ourselves up by running others down. But we do not add stature to ourselves by belittling the stature of others. If it is our business to look for faults and flaws, then we must do what it is our business to do. But for most of us it would be wiser not to overwork ourselves at fault-finding, for we all say or do things which may not sound or seem to others as we intend they should sound or seem — and any man may be made an offender for a word; any utterance may be misconstrued; and character may be condemned; any motive may be misunderstood. If it is trouble we are looking for, if it is faults and flaws we want, we shall find them. But with those we live with, we shall live happier lives if we don't pursue our search too persistently.

One of the universal wishes of humanity is that humanity were somehow different. Even those we love sincerely, we love with an awareness of their faults. We yearn always for better things in them. We cherish and respect our neighbors and friends but wish that we did not see in them those traits of human weakness which are common in greater or less degree in all mortal men, and with which we,

ourselves, are so generously endowed, and to which we are blind, or partially so, in our own lives. In short, we wish that other men were different; but since they are as they are, we must accept them as they are. Any movement, creed, or society that does less than this, does not justify its own existence. The Lord himself, when he walked the earth, did not expect perfection in men. He chose unlettered fishermen to be His apostles, and helped them to broader vision and greater service. The primary purpose of all human endeavor is to take men as they are and help them to become better. And on that day when we lose sight of this reason for our existence, we shall be without a purpose worthy of perpetuation. In the wisdom of Providence, finding ourselves as we are, it is our eternal hope that we shall continually become better than we are, and, the Lord willing, we shall so move on together, Kindness should be cultivated on all relationship of life; between parents and children; between brothers and sisters; teachers and students; neighbor to neighbor; and every man to every other. The quality of kindness is in part the essence of the message of the Master of mankind, with love and peace and respect for people.

Aside from his manifold work in the CEA, our good Brother Mauro, who is a prolific writer and lecturer for and in behalf of our Fraternity, finds time for educational activity, being Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Union College of Manila."

MW Mauro O. Baradi was recently appointed Ambassador to

Kennya by President Ferdinand E. Marcos.

But there's one member of the Philippine Ambassadors' Association who should be "expelled" for deserting their cause: that of being always together to relieve their past glories as chiefs of mission.

He's ex-Ambassador Mauro Baradi who, at the age of 75 (the age the General feels like), has decided to re-enter the foreign service as ambassador to an African country.

There's only one possible explanation for the apostasy of this brilliant lawyer, orator and constitutionalist.

He loves Africans, he talks African and he looks African."

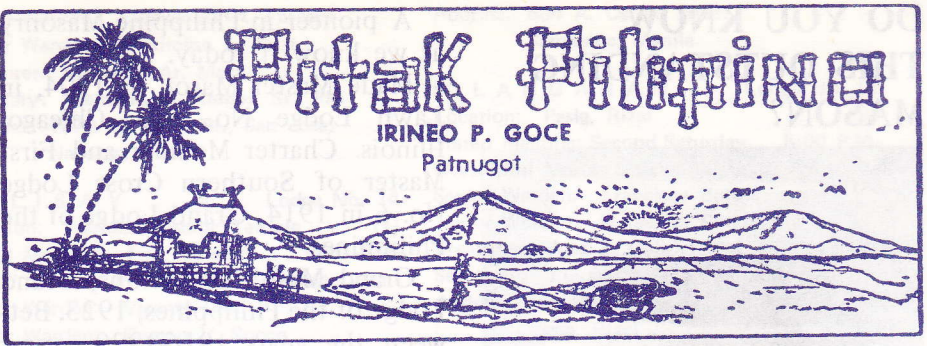

DE MOLAY SPONSORSHIP

The immediate supervision of every DeMolay chapter lies in the hands of an Advisory Council. This Advisory Council is composed of interested Masons from the sponsoring body. One of the members of the Advisory Council is designated the "Chapter Dad" and is the main counselor and advisor to the chapter members. This Chapter Dad is a friend whom each member of a chapter can look upon as a person to whom problems can be taken with understanding.

Pinagpipitaganan at ginigiliw kong mga Kapatid:

Ipaubaya po ninyo na ang **Pitak** na ito ay iukol ko ngayon sa isang kalatas mula sa malayong dako na aking kinaroroonan. Ako'y nananalig na sa pamamagitan nito ay mabibigyang daan na maibahagi ang kabatiran mula sa aking mga pagmamasid ukol sa ating mabunying Kapatiran.

Sa ikababatid ng lahat, ako po ay ipinadala ng ating Pamahalaang bansa bilang tugon sa anyaya ng Britanya na magpa-aral sa ilalim ng tinatawag na **Colombo Plan**. Isa po ako sa labindalawang kinatawan mula sa iba't-ibang bansa, na kasalukuyang kumukuha ng kursong **Press and Publications**, sa pangangasiwa ng **Central Office of Information** ng Britanya at sa pagtataguyod naman ng **British Council**. Umalis ako sa Maynila nuong ika-4 ng Ene-rong nagdaan. Mahigit pang isang

buwan marahil bago ako bumalik sa Pilipinas.

Ang nais ko pong talakayin ay nauukol sa ating Kapatiran dini sa Britanya. Ang sinumang Kapatid mula sa ating bayan, o kahi't saan pa mang bansa, na magagawi dini sa London ay hindi dapat kalimutang paghanapin ang Freemasons' Hall. Ito ay isang napakagandang gusali, na nagsisilbing Bantayog Pangkapayapaan ng Masoneriya (Masonic Peace Memorial), at punong-tanggapan ng Inang Gran Lohiya sa Daigdig. Matatagpuan po ang gusaling ito sa silangang gilid ng Great Queen Street, London, WC2B 5AZ, sa kalagitnaan nitong lungsod.

Talagang lubos na makasaysayan ang gusaling ito sapagka't ang pandaigdig na paglaganap ng Masone-riya ay dini nagmula. Ang kauna-unahang Gran Lohiya o **Premier Grand Lodge** sa daigdig ay natatag

nuong 1717, at itong **Freemasons' Hall** ay sinimulan namang itayo nuong 1775. Nang wala pa ito, ang **Grand Lodge of England** ay paibaiba ng lugar ang mga pagmimiting — sa mga Gusaling Lungsod o mga Taberna sa London.

Ang una kong pagkakataon na makarating sa **Freemasons' Hall** ay ika-14 nitong Pebrero (St. Valentine's Day). Nagpakilala ako sa katumong ng **Grand Secretary**, at itinala sa Indise ng Grand Lodge ang mga bagay at detalye ukol sa akin. Kasabay ng iba pang mga kapatid mula sa malalayong dako ng Britanya, na nagsadya upang tingnan din itong Gran Lohiya, isang giya ang nagdala sa amin sa Aklatan, sa Museo, at sa Grand Lodge, at pati sa **Lodge No. 10** na karaniwang ipinakikita sa mga bisita, sa isang panig ng gusali.

Ang malaking kaibahan na napan-sin ko kaagad ay ang hindi nila pagkakaroon ng Altar sa gitna ng Lohiya. Ang banal na Kasulatan ay sa harapan ng Worshipful Master binubuksan, at ang bawa't pagtaas o pagbaba ng sa lohiyang antas ay sinasabayan ng pag-iiba ng **Trestle Board** sa harapan ng Junior Warden. Ang tatlong **Lesser Lights** ay tig-isa sa gilid ng mesa ng tatlong mga "Pilar" o Haligi ng lohiya.

Sa tanggapan ng Grand Secretary ay binigyan ako ng sipi ng isang Pasugo, o **Summons**, sa mga kasapi ng Three Pillars Lodge No. 4923, para dumalo sa Regular Meeting kinabukasan (ika-15 ng Prebrero). Napansin ko kaagad na mayroong **passing**, at saka **initiation**. Pagkaka-

taon ko upang masaksihan ang kani-lang pagtanggap sa kandidato.

Pagkauwi sa hotel ay kaagad kong tinawag si WB Charles J. Carter, ang Kalihim ng Three Pillars. Nagpakilala ako at nagsabi na hindi pa ako nakasaksi ng miting ng alin-mang lohiya dini sa London. Pagkaraan ng kaunting usapan ay inanyayahan niya akong dumalo sa miting nila. Sapagka't nalaman niyang wala akong **apron**, sinabi niyang magpaaga ako ng dating at pabibigyan niya ako sa Tyler.

Ganoon nga ang nangyari; 15 minuto pa bago magsimula ang ika-3:00 sa hapon nilang palatuntunan ay nandoon na ako. Ipinagtanong ko si WB Carter; ako'y kaniyang sinalubong at ipinakilala sa ibang mga kapatid. Pinabigyan ako ng **apron**, at pati guwantes na puti sapagka't kung may **conferral** ay naka-guwantes ng puti ang lahat na naroroon.

Napakalaking kaibahan ang mga pamamaraan sa kanilang pagtanggap sa kandidato, at ang paggawad ng antas. Datapuwa't hindi dapat isalaysay dito ang mga iyon.

Ang pinakatampok ng miting ay inisasyon. Batangbata ang kandidato, na ngayo'y Kap. Charles Bruce Dixon, 29 na taong gulang at inhinyero sa **computer**.

Pagkatapos ng inisasyon ay naghalalan, at ang bagong kasapi ay bumoto na rin! Ang mga hinalal ay: Master ng Lohiya, Ingat-Yaman, Tyler, Tatlong Awditor, at apat na mga kasapi sa Committee on Management (ang ibang kasapi ay matataas na mga opisyal ng lohiya).

Isang napakaringal na salu-salo (hapunan) ang sumunod sa mga pag-inom sa karatig na bar, pagkatapos na masara ang lohiya. At bago ko malimutan, ang Templo ng **Three Pillars** ay napakaganda, subali't tagung-tago! Nasa ikalawang palapag sa pailalim (2nd basement) ng Angus Steak House, 74 Regent Street, London W.1.

Ang timbulan ng lahat na mga atensiyon ay ang bagong kasapi na nakaupo sa kanan ng Worshipful Master sa hapag. Halos lahat na mga usapan ay ukol sa kaniya, may espesyal siyang parangal sa pagtagay ng alak, at ang isang sipi ng **Summons** na nilagdaan ng lahat na naroon sa kaniyang inisasyon ay pormal na ihinandog sa kaniya ng Worshipful Master. Maliban sa bagong kasapi, ako ay tumanggap din ng **Summons** na may lagda ang lahat na mga kasapi ng Three Pillars na naroon.

Magbalik po tayo sa **Freemasons' Hall**. Ang kaunaunahang batong pundasyon ng pinakaunang gusali ay inilagak nuong Mayo 1, 1775. Ang ikalawang gusali na pumalit sa nauna ay binuksan nuong Abril 14,

1869; at ang ikatlo, Hulyo 19, 1933, ay nakatayo pa hanggang ngayon. Narini ang administrasyon ng **United Grand Lodge of England** na nakasasaklaw sa mga pamprobinsiya at pandistritong Gran Lohiya, at may 6,500 na pribadong mga lohiya sa buong nasasakupan ng Imperiyong Britanya.

Ukol sa Templong ito ay may nagsabi: "Ang bago nating Templo ay matatayo hindi lamang bilang isang Bantayog para sa mga pumanaw na kungdi isa ring hudyat at inspirasyon para sa mga nabubuhay, nang sa ganoon ay ang mga bagong saling-lahi ay magsumikap ng may ibayong kasiglahan sa pagtatayo nuong hindi nakikitang Templo na hindi niyari ng mga kamay, na siyang kahulihulihan at pinakamatayog na mithiin ng ating Kapatiran."

Hanggang dito po muna, mahal kong mga Kapatid, at maalab na alaala ang kalakip nito para sa inyong lahat.

ON MASONIC EDUCATION

386. *Why was it necessary to have three degrees?*

It is necessary for Freemasonry to have three degrees to symbolize the three principal periods of man's existence, namely, youth, manhood, and age. Because of this fact Freemasonry furnishes in the Entered Apprentice Degree moral instruction; in the Fellow Craft, Intellectual; and the Master Mason, spiritual.

387. *What part of the Temple of Solomon was The Middle Chamber?*

The Middle Chamber is not properly a part of the Temple. It was the second story of the three-story structure build against the north, west, and south walls of the Temple of Solomon. The entrance was on the south wall and the second story is reached by means of a winding staircase.

388. *What is implied by the statement the "covering of a Lodge is no less than the clouded canopy or star-decked heaven"?*

The statement "clouded canopy or star-decked heaven" refers to the time when the temples had no roofs.

389. *What form of art has from the earliest times been associated with religion?*

From the earliest times architecture has been associated with religion. Men sought not only to build a shelter for himself but also a house for his God.

390. *What was the name of the Mohawk Indian who became a Freemason in England during the American Revolution?*

According to E. L. Hawkuns (*A Concise Cyclopaedia of Freemasonry*) a Mohawk Indian was made a Freemason in London in 1776. He commanded some Indian troops which fought on the British side. Capt. McKinsty of the American forces was captured by Brant's men who tied him to a tree to scalp him when Brant interposed when he saw the prisoner give the G.H.S. He freed him and took him to Quebec and placed him in the hands of some English Freemasons who returned him uninjured to the American lines.
