## *Grand Master's Page*



### GREETINGS MY BELOVED BRETHREN:

I consider it a great privilege and the highest honor to occupy the Grand Oriental Chair. I wish to express my profound gratitude to the Brethren for this inestimable gift, and would like to give my solemn pledge that I will try to serve with honor and dedication, which I hope will be worthy of the great tradition set forth by my illustrious predecessors.

Under my stewardship, we have initiated a slight change in the tone of this column, "The Grand Master's Page". . . . a corner designed to give informative values of interest and for the betterment of the Craft. The editorial thrust, however, shall remain the same. If you will further note, we have a new team of dedicated and intensely motivated Brethren now occupying major slots in the executive and editorial board. We resolve to make this a vibrant and Masonically informative magazine responsive to the intellectual needs of the Brethren which shall be regularly placed in your hands.

Although devoutly to be wished, we do not intend to move mountains, but rather set forth attainable goals for the tasks ahead. Oddly enough, the goals we have set for ourselves are actually the basic Masonic obligations that we normally regard, but often times neglect, as our primary duties and responsibilities.

There is no doubt that our immediate priority is the resumption of the construction of our Grand Lodge Temple. The work has ground to a halt due to a depletion of our Temple funds. Hence, we consider it vital at this moment to set our direction for a positive response to our appeal for the immediate remittance of the Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) pledges for the Grand Lodge Temple Fund. This gigantic project, wisely conceived by PGM Desiderio Dalisay, boldly initiated by Past Grand Master Jolly R. Bugarin and vigorously implemented by Immediate Past Grand Master Manuel D. Mandac is in sacred pursuit of the establishment of a lasting monument worthy of our total image as Freemasons. The empty shell of our unfinished edifice now stands woefully forlorn and abandoned. We can not steal a glance at this ugly nakedness without invoking within our hearts a frantic sense of challenge to its eventual completion.

We wish to profoundly acknowledge the magnificent, untiring and unselfish efforts jointly lavished by WB Atanacio Bayan, project engineer; VW Urbano S. Caasi, Jr., architect; and WB Mamerto Buenafe, electrical engineer, to the initial construction of our temple. Neither rain, nor heat, nor hunger, nor frustratingly insurmountable problems have deterred or diminished their firm determination to finish the task assigned to them. Alas, momentarily they repose in abject resignation.

The morning prior to the public installation of the Grand Lodge officers, we had the opportunity to lengthily confer with all the newly appointed DDGMs and DGLs, wherein we discussed and defined our Masonic program for the year. Most heartily, all were in agreement that strict, uncompromising, conscientious supervision and management of the Blue Lodges shall merit our collective undivided concern and attention. To this end, District Grand Officers shall endeavor to visit and personally observe and supervise as often as possible all Lodge proceedings under their respective jurisdictions. Of equal importance to this supervision and control shall be the proficient and dignified conduct of Lodge rituals and ceremonies; regular submission by the Secretaries of all written reports as required by our regulations; prompt remittance of all dues; increased participation by members to encourage attendance; special emphasis on active supervision by Grand Lodge Inspectors; an intensive program of Masonic Education under the direction of the District Grand Lecturers; and, finally, needless to repeat, generous remittances to the Temple Fund.

It was a difficult decision. The raffle committee under the chairmanship of RW Rosendo C. Herrera, SGW, with the approval of PGM Mandac, decided at the last hour to regretfully postpone the raffle draw to a later date — tentatively sometime in December. The reason was purely arithmetic. We failed to generate enough subscription to meet our minimum commitments. We took into consideration the adverse effect in some quarters, a calculated risk we were prepared to gamble to salvage a worthy project. We need your understanding and support more than ever.

Our first official function as Grand Master was very pleasant. We represented the Grand Lodge during the Grand Court Session of the Order of the Amaranth, Inc., held at the Scottish Rite Temple on April 26th. The Grand Royal Matron is the very charming, vivacious and delicately energetic Honored Lady Annie Dalisay, the daughter-in-law of PGM Desiderio Dalisay, who extended to us a most gracious reception. Our thanks to HL Annie and the rest of the Court. Interestingly, HL Elizabeth Araneta, charming lady of MW Grand Treasurer Jose L. Araneta, is the incumbent Supreme Associate Conductress of the Supreme Council of the Order of the Amaranth, Inc. Next year she will serve as Supreme Conductress, the highest yet ever attained by a Filipina. We are very proud of her achievement.

The Supreme Council of Scottish Rite Freemasonry, through PGM and Illustrious Sovereign Grand Commander Raymond E. Wilmarth,

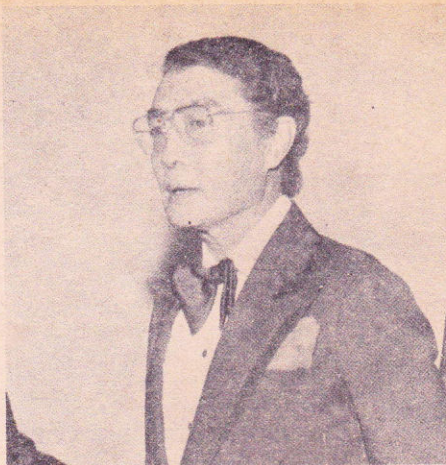

## **MW SIMEON RENE LACSON**

Some twelve years ago, someone knocked on the door of Freemasonry unsure of his future. Strangely enough, after he was initiated an Entered Apprentice and passed to the Fellow Craft, it was not until after two years that he was raised to the degree of Master Mason. Taking root in F.D. Roosevelt Memorial Lodge No. 81 as Master Mason on March 7, 1970, Grand Master Simeon Rene Lacson took to heart his membership that the next year he was elected as Worshipful Master of his Lodge. The Brethren upon seeing the Lodge becoming a beehive of activities gave him another year to implement his program of direction. From then on, there was no stopping Worshipful Master Rene Lacson. By 1973, Most Worshipful

Master Ruperto Demonteverde, appointed him as the Grand Standard Bearer and in 1975 the Most Worshipful Teodoro Kalaw, Jr. made him the Grand Bible Bearer. The meteoric rise of the MW Grand Master was phenomenal. Literally, he involved himself in all existing allied and appendant bodies seemingly making up for lost time.

Before becoming a member of the Craft, MW Rene Lacson, President of Lacson Colleges and the Philippine law School, was very active in the Lions Club, joining the Pasay City Lions Club in 1951. He was President of said organization in 1954. In 1964, he was elected District Governor of Lions District 301-A, Lions International. He served the civic organization once more in 1968 and was rated as ONE

HUNDRED PERCENT District Governor during his term, one of only eleven 100% District Governors among more than fifty-odd others who have served in this position in Philippine Lionism. He holds a lifetime title of International Counsellor of Lions International. In 1969, he was the Convention Chairman of the 7th Orient in South East Asia Lions Convention held in Manila which at that time was participated in by nine Lions countries in Asia. There is no doubt that Grand Master Rene has etched a niche for himself in the hall of fame of the world of Lionism.

His membership in other civic organizations include the Pasay City Chapter of the Philippine National Red Cross, which he served for the last 27 years. He is Past Chairman and President of the Pasay Chest Clinic for the Philippine Anti-Tuberculosis Society, where he served in the Board of Directors for the past twenty-five years up to the present time. A member of the Philippine Cancer Society, and Boy Scout Chapter, Pasay City, he is also a member of the Defenders of Bataan and Corregidor and served as Post Commander of Post 37 for 3 consecutive terms in the American Legion.

Grand Master Lacson was called to active duty right after graduating law from the Philippine Law School. Inducted in the United States Armed Forces in the Far East (USAFFE), he was designated Executive Officer of "C" Company, 1st Battalion, 72nd Infantry Regiment, one of the three infantry regiments of the 71st division

which were mobilized in Negros Occidental composed mainly of trainees and reservists of the province.

"On December 6, 1941, my infantry embarked by inter-island vessel from Fabrica, Negros Occidental to Manila, arrived the following day, and immediately proceeded to our cantonment in Capas, Tarlac. The next day was December 8th. The 71st Infantry Division was part of the USAFFE which defended Luzon against the Japanese invaders. We later on engaged the enemy in a series of withdrawal-holding actions particularly in Sison, Pozorrubio, Binalonan and Tayug, Pangasinan; along some other nameless points on the way down to Baliwag, Bulacan. We finally withdrew to the Bagac sector in Bataan." After the historic Bataan surrender on April 9, 1941, Grand Master Rene survived the "death march" from the vanquished US Army bastion of Bataan to the internment Camp in Capas, Tarlac.

"After fifty-nine thousand deaths later, I was made burial-officer-of-the-day. It was my misfortune to keep count of the dead we buried. I was released in November 1942. Thank God it was not much later otherwise, I would have written my 30's." Of course, M.W. Rene's involvement with the army did not end with his release. A year and a half later, he joined the East Central Luzon Guerilla Area (ECLGA) operating within the Manila area and suburbs.

"I served the Army after liberation in 1945 and remained in the service doing routine duties until

1948".

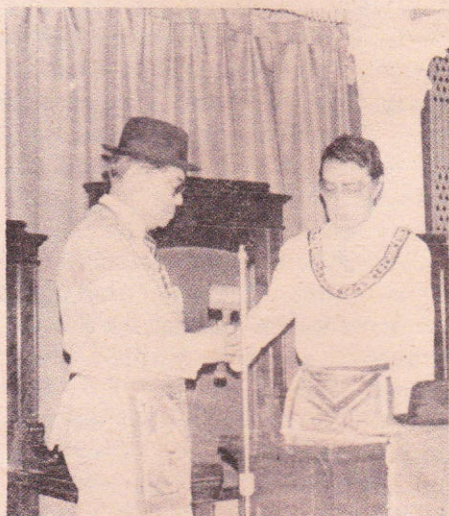
After Grand Master Rene was demobilized from the military service in 1948, he immediately assumed the position of Registrar-Comptroller of the Philippine Law School and Lacson College, educational institutions wholly owned by his family, and later on assumed the Presidency of both schools when his uncle passed away in 1960.

"I consider myself ethnically a native of Silay City, where all my folks came from although I was born on April 21, 1918 at the old St. Paul Hospital in Intramuros, Manila. This 'accident' of birth was due to the fact that my family was in Manila at that time where my father, Simeon C. Lacson was a practicing lawyer. He unfortunately died in 1926 when I was eight years old" M.W. Rene confessed recalling fond memories of the Walled City before the Second World War.

In 1969, together with a group of friends and business associates, Grand Master Rene incorporated the Carmen Mindanao Mining Co., Inc. and served as Vice-President for International Affairs up to the present. He is the President of the Gumban Copper Mines Inc., with mining claims in Basay, Negros Oriental. A farmer gentleman, he is an active sugar planter with sugar plantations in Silay City, Saravia, Victorias and Cadiz, Negros Occidental.

Grand Master Rene Lacson has many loves both in the business as well as in the civic world, but his dedication to Masonry is without parallel. Eight years after he was raised as a Master Mason, he was elected as Jr. Grand Warden in 1978

and moved up until he was elevated to his present exalted position. A member of the Luzon Bodies, he is also a member of the York Rite Bodies serving as Excellent High Priest in 1981 in Manila Chapter No. 2, Royal Arch Masons (R.A.M.), Grand Chaplain, Grand Chapter of R.A.M., and Grand Representative of the Grand Chapter of R.A.M. of Nevada, U.S.A. He was Deputy Illustrious Master of Oriental Council No. 1 of the Royal and Select Masters; Grand Captain of the Guards of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of the Philippines and Grand Representative of the Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters of New Hampshire, U.S.A. He served as Eminent Commander of Far East Commandery No. 1 of the Knights Templar. This year, he was named Grand Prelate of the Grand Commandery

of Knights Templar of the Philippines. He is also Grand Representative of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Denver, Colorado, U.S.A. His membership in other appendant orders include Far East Court No. 1, Order of the Amaranth Inc.; Sampaguita Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star, and Islam Temple, Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, with headquarters in San Francisco, California, U.S.A.

"I do not believe in starting with a bang and ending in a whimper. I believe that by doing little things which are basic in promoting Grand Lodge harmony, I will be contributing towards the program initiated by my predecessors. There is a need to examine the system of collecting what is due the Grand Lodge. If only blue lodge secretaries will be faithful in performing their tasks,

the setting of priorities would not be that difficult. I am disturbed by the fact that until now the brethren who have promised to give their share of P200.00 to the temple fund have been remiss in fulfilling their vows. If I will be able to accomplish the collection of all the dues for the Grand Lodge and for all the pledges made by our brethren during my term, then I feel that I have served my time. To me this is basic. We cannot talk of anything worthwhile when our coffers are empty."

I could only wish the Grand Master luck. Rome was not built in a day's time. We need a man with a vision. And, along with that vision, a managerial know-how to streamline operational thrusts. With Grand Master Simeon Rene Lacson's background we have a promise of a better tomorrow.

# The 65th ANNUAL COMMUNICATION

An annual recurrence in Philippine Masonry which is eagerly awaited by all Masons in this jurisdiction is the Annual Communication of the Grand Lodge of the Philippines. This year's Communication, the 65th, was held from April 23 to 25, 1981 at the Plaridel Masonic Temple, San Marcelino St., Manila.

*First Day* — In accordance with custom, the Communication begun with a floral offering at the statues of Bros. Marcelo H. del Pilar, Jose Rizal and Graciano Lopez-Jaena at the foyer of the temple. Thereafter the delegates proceeded to the Jose Abad Hall for the opening of the Grand Lodge. After the opening rites, Justice Ramon Fernandez, of the Supreme Court, was received into the Communication to deliver the keynote address. After the keynote

speaker left, the body tackled the reports of the various Grand Officers and Committees.

VW Raymundo N. Beltran delivered the Grand oration.

The Acacia Mutual Aid Society, Inc., held its Annual General Meeting.

The degree of Installed or Past Master was conferred by RW Herogenes P. Oliveros.

The Grand Master's Fellowship Night capped the first day of the Communication. The affair was held at the new temple construction site. Invited singers were on hand to entertain the delegates and their ladies. Prizes for the winners in the sports tourneys (Bowling, Chess and Golf) were awarded.

*Second day* — On the second day of the Communication, the Masonic Hospital for Crippled Children held its meeting. Bro. Rivera reported on the activities of the Hospital and presented actual cases handled.

After lunch, the annual meeting of the Cabletow, Inc. was held at the new temple site. This meeting saw

a "changing of the guards". Six new faces were elected to the Board of Trustees of the Cabletow signaling a revamp of its leadership.

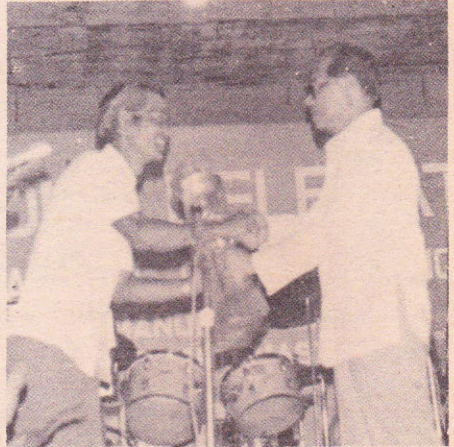
The highlight of the second day of the Communication was, of course, the election and appointment of the new set of Grand Lodge officers. As expected, and in line with tradition in our Grand Lodge, Deputy Grand Master Simeon Rene Lacson, Senior Grand Warden Rudyardo V. Bunda and Junior Grand Warden Rosendo C. Herrera each went up one wrung in the ladder of leadership. RW Lacson was overwhelmingly elected Grand Master, while RW Bunda and RW Herrera were chosen Deputy Grand Master and Senior Grand Warden, respectively. MW Jose L. Araneta, who has been serving as Grand Treasurer since 1978, was also re-elected virtually unopposed.

The elections which attracted the attention of the Bethren were those for Junior Grand Warden and Grand Secretary.

The position of Grand Secretary became vacant upon the death of our late beloved Grand Secretary Esteban Munarriz, PGM, who had held the position for 25 years from

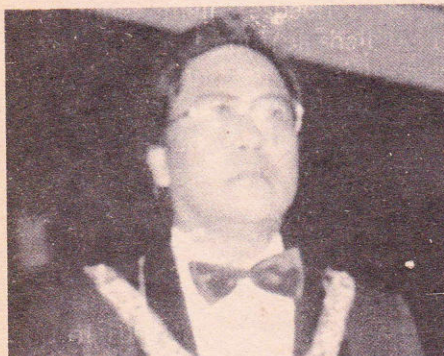

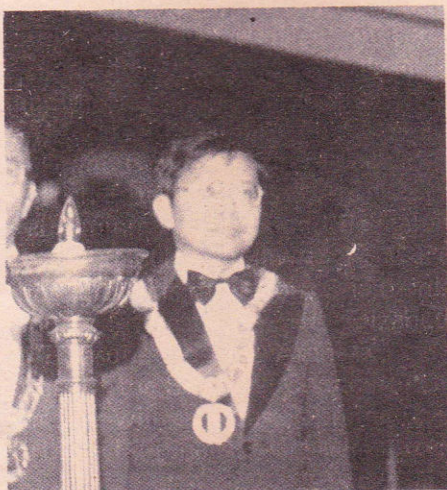

1956 to 1981. The names of several prominent Masons were mentioned as his possible successors.

For the position of Junior Grand Warden, the Past Grand Masters recommended three distinguished Masons for the consideration of the Brethren, namely, Pedro Wong Guerzon, Reynato Serrano Puno and George Frank Krause.

Bro. GUERZON is a Past Master of Macajalar Lodge No. 184 in Cagayan de Oro City and is very active in the Fraternity. He was Grand Lodge Inspector in 1974-75; District Deputy Grand Master in 1977-80; and, Grand Marshall in 1980-81. He served with distinction in several appendant Masonic organizations, such as, the Order of DeMolay, International Order for Rainbow Girls, Eastern Star and Scottish Rite.

Bro. PUNO is a Past Master of Hiram Lodge, Past Grand Orator, Past District Deputy Grand Master, and has served on several Grand Lodge Committees. He is also active



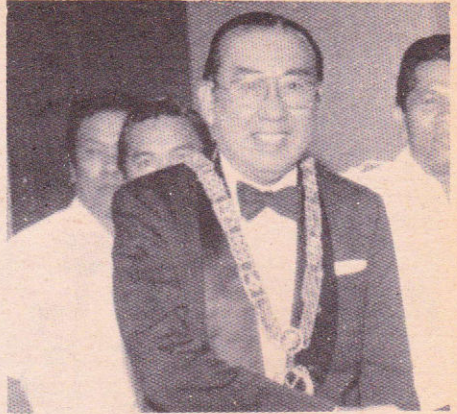

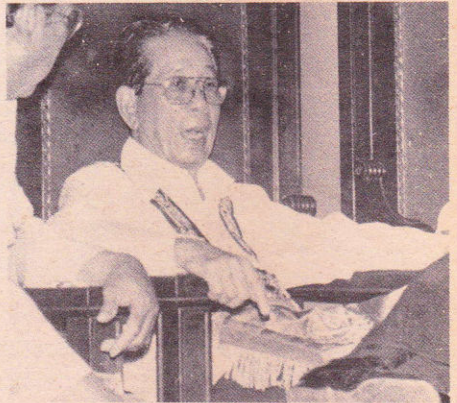
in Royal Arch Masonry and in the Scottish Rite. He received the TOYM award in the field of law in 1977 and was recently appointed by President Marcos to the Court of Appeals.

Bro. KRAUSE is a Past Master of MacArthur Lodge No. 180 in Korea and is the Past District Deputy Grand Master of District No. 30. He holds a Civil Engineering degree from the University of Washington and is presently the Vice-President of FEMCO with assignment in Seoul, Korea.

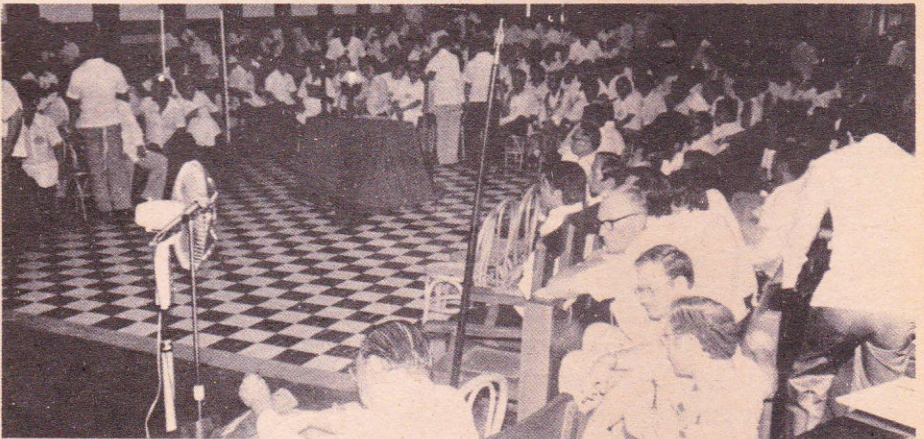
In the elections which ensued, MW Manuel Crudo, PGM was elected Grand Secretary. Another Past Grand Master, Ruperto Demonte-verde Sr., came in a close second. For the position of Junior Grand Warden the result was a surprising deadlock. Both Bros. Puno and Guerzon received an identical 354 votes, the first time, according to many old hands in the Grand Lodge, that an election for Junior Grand Warden resulted in a tie. Bro. Krause was not in contention, probably because he lacks exposure

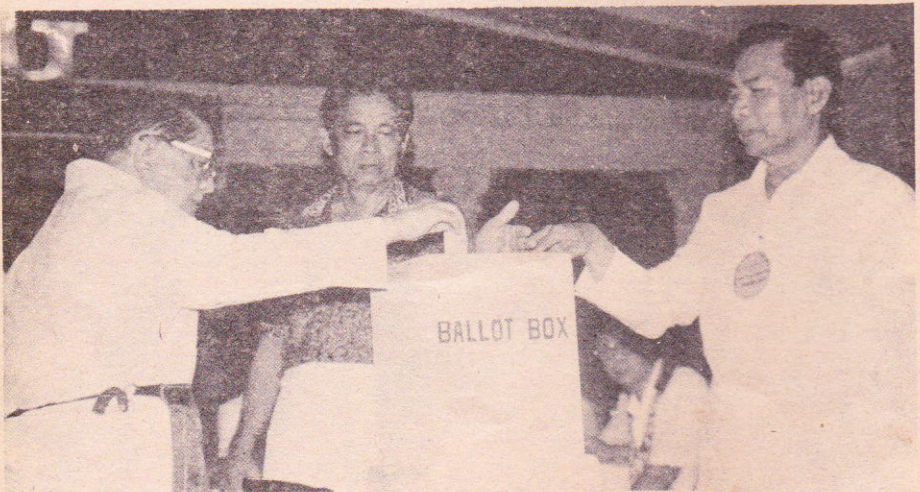


*"COMELEC" Chairman Ray Beltran ponders an election problem. Big and small, he solved them all.*

among the local brethren. In the second balloting, Bro. Puno was elected with a comfortable margin. Among the first to give him a fraternal congratulatory embrace was his defeated opponent, Bro. Guerson. After the elections, Bro. Raymundo Beltran, Chairman of the Election Committee, was roundly congratulated by the Brethren for a very orderly election.

Grand Secretary-elect.

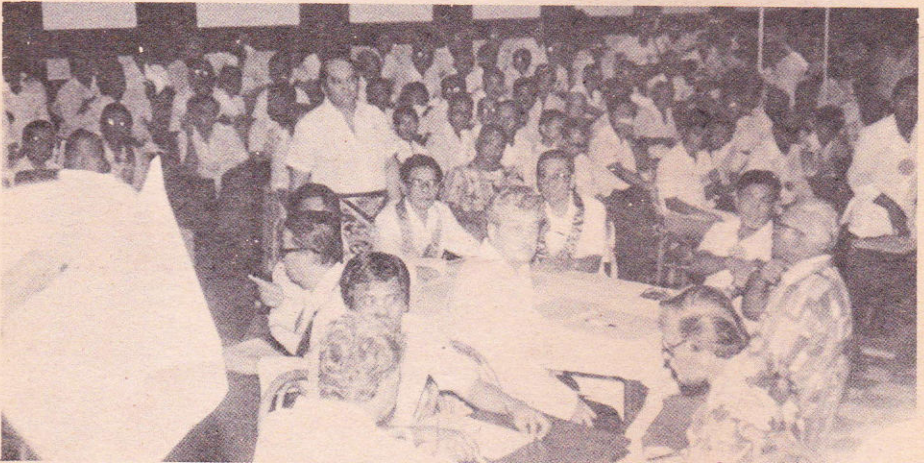
In the evening of the third day, the new Grand Officers were installed at the Jose Abad Santos Hall. MW Manuel D. Mandac installed the officers in public form with the assistance of MW Damaso C. 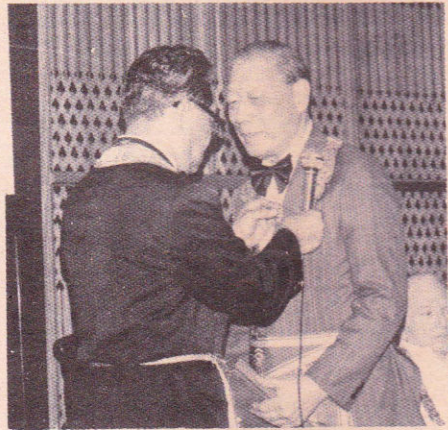

(4) The creation of a committee to see to the organization of a provisional Supreme Council of DeMolay in this jurisdiction; and,

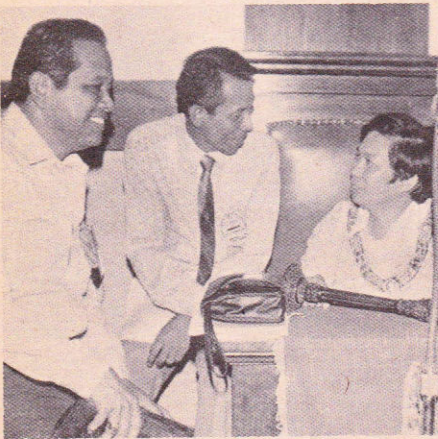

# **MEDITATIONS OF A MASON**

I am a member of Kidapawan Lodge No. 170, F. & A. M., Kidapawan, North Cotabato, for more than two years now. As an officer of this Lodge, I have had opportunities of participating in stated meetings and in various parts of Degree Work. Like any other Master Mason, I have read and was told that our Masonic Lodge is full of symbolisms. These symbols, I have learned, are not intended to conceal but to ever reveal the "truth" to those who can meditate upon it further. Aside from our Masonic Lodge symbolisms, we also have floor work and degree work that are full of allegorical meanings. As we meditate further upon these Masonic symbols and allegorical "dramas", each one of us will find slightly different interpretations in our minds depending upon our experiences and intellectual backgrounds.

In my own meditations our Masonic Lodge and degree work became a miniature world in which life exists. In my mind's eye there came

a parallelism between the Lodge and the World, and between the three degrees and life itself. The Masonic Lodge became a "microcosm", or the World in which we live in, the course of human life, and an ideal life for human affair.

The Lodge has a symbolic "Sun". This "Sun" rises in the East, sends forth "Light" into the Lodge in the form of knowledge, provides "heat energy" in the form of Brotherly love and relief, and allows "growth, locomotion, and life" by governing the Lodge. All of these are made possible by the creative power of the Supreme Architect of the Universe or God which is reflected in the center of the Lodge as the Trinity of Lights.

Contemplating upon these symbolisms, my mind goes back in time to 1350 B.C. in Egypt where Pharaoh Akhnaton or Amenhotep IV, King of Egypt during the 18th Dynasty, proclaimed to the world his cognizance and due honor given to this great and natural phenomena in the East notwithstanding the misconceptions attached to him by the unenlightened masses during his time and even today. To Pharaoh Akhnaton, the Sun was not God, but a symbol of that One Divine and Creative power from which all the Earth receives light and life.

The allegories of the three Masonic degrees - initiation, passing, and raising - find a place in my mind as a miniature story of human life itself. In my meditation, we are all initiated into this world during our birth. The "door" was "opened" and into this world we were admitted "blind, poor, and naked". We

saw the Light, but still we were ignorant and baffled by the unexplained phenomena of nature. We put our trust only in God, whatever we conceive Him to be. Our only "guide" then is our moral conscience, that "still small voice" that speaks to us from within.

We "pass" through this life learning the lessons thereof. Others have the opportunity for formal education. Others through self study and non-formal setting. And still others learn by experience, the greatest "teacher" from nature. All these, we are taught, are necessary for "manhood", that phase of our greatest responsibility towards mankind, the "building of a Temple in the hearts of men", to the "glory of God". Thus endeavoring to build the Brotherhood of Men under the Fatherhood of only one God.

Our way is through "rough and rugged roads, full of trials and tribulations", "man being born of a woman", "full of sorrow". Material wealth becomes no guarantee for peace, love, harmony, and happiness. To me, they are only a necessity to maintain the expression of life.

Notwithstanding the "truth", man's grosser nature, his "ruffian" nature, becomes so easily swayed by the allurements of materialism (the temptation of the Serpent), the desire for knowledge (the Secrets of a Master Mason), that he "eats the fruit" thereof, thereby becoming aware only of his material part, "the naked body". Thus, the immaterial part of man was "murdered" and "buried" in the

cloak of materialism, the bodily passion. Man then became *unaware* of his immortality. He became ignorant that he is a "soul" cloaked in a material body. Thus the "Word" was "Lost".

However, our GMHA was "raised". This, to my mind, reminds us that our immaterial part, the "soul", is immortal. This is our hope and faith. Through our material bodies, the "acasia" still lives, though "easily giving way".

The "raising" of our immortal soul "from the grave", the "raising" of our GMHA, becomes a portent to me that the "Lost Word" is still *attainable*.

The attainment of the "Lost Word" now takes a process of redemption. It becomes a process whereby man must make a journey from the *sense life* of "Babylon" to the *place of the spirit* at "Jerusalem" where the Temple (a new life) must be rebuilt and the "Lost Word" recovered. This brings my mind to what Jesus Christ said, "I and my Father are one".

Contemplating upon the story told in the Holy Bible about Jesus, the Christ, in my mind's eyes I saw the greatest exemplar ever to walk on Earth. He was initiated, passed, and raised in this macrocosm. The Thrice Illustrious and Lord of the Christians Jesus Christ was "initiated" to life, "passed" and fulfilled his mission through "rough and rugged roads", "beset with ruffians", crucified, buried, and "raised" from the grave. This exemplification of Jesus Christ becomes a revelation about the Mystery of the Mysteries to those who have "ears

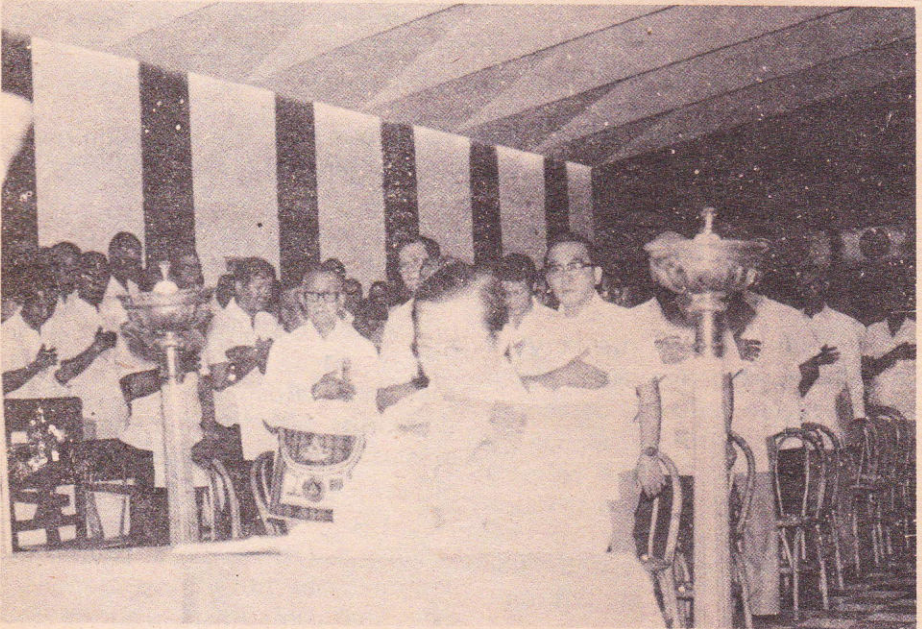

to hear". To the profane world, it was a drama and a story to tell, a "truth" being veiled in allegory and full of symbolism. To those who have "ears to hear" and *an eye to see*, the renting of "the veil of the Temple" in twain from top to bottom (Mark 15:38) when Jesus "gave up the ghost" was a revelation about the Holy of Holies, the Mystery of the Mysteries.

Thus in my meditation, this World we live in is a macro-Lodge, presided and governed by the "Supreme Grand Master, Ruler of Heaven and Earth". All men are Brothers in this macro-Lodge, regardless of race and creed, under the Fatherhood of only One God, the Supreme Architect of the Universe. Though this idealism is far from

what we can see and hear in this present word situation, all Masons are striving towards it beginning in and from our Masonic Lodges, where Brotherhood, peace, harmony, and truth ever exist guided by the unseen hand of God.

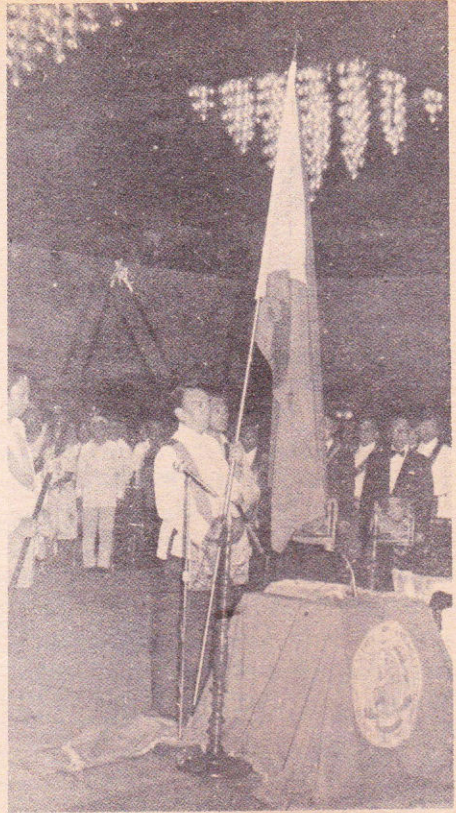

# The PHILIPPINE FLAG

I was constrained to scribble some serious thoughts about the Philippine flag, especially at this point in time when the national anthem is the subject of pun and fun in a foreign land.

One who makes a mockery of the anthem, which is a sacred hymn sung to revere the flag, desecrates the flag. By doing so, he has no love and respect for the country and the people that that flag represents. Like the doctrine on the Divine Trinity, the anthem, the flag and the country are all but one.

In the past, everytime I looked

up at our flag, the following questions entered my mind:

Why a flag to symbolize the strength of our unity as a people and a nation? Why just a piece of colored cloth that easily turns into a rag in a short time, colors that fade under the sun, a thing that drips with the rain and which must sway and fly where the wind blows?

Why not steel or a chunk of granite? Why not a massive monument that can withstand all the elements?

## THE FLAG

The answer is simple as I found out later during a chance meeting with an elder who was beginning to fade away from life like an old and tattered flag.

At that precise moment, it occurred to me like a flash of light what a flag truly meant and the word *life* sunk deep into my consciousness.

The flag has its own life; periods of conception, infancy, youth, maturity, death and resurrection. Balls of thread first, then flannels of colored cloth, then a flag that ages and dies, and resurrected in the form of a new one.

It uniquely represents national life, and all the virtues that enhance the quality of life—solidarity, purpose, dedication, loyalty, hope and courage.

Every thread in the flag corresponds to a unit or segment of life in society that woven with all the others sum up to 47 million Filipinos—solid, purposeful, dedicated, loyal, hopeful and courageous.

The flag is emblematical of the life-cycle of every Filipino, and more important the philosophy that motivates him into action and his vision to meet the challenges of life.

By this attitude, the Filipino is so much like the flag he loves. He stands before the savage elements of nature, he ages, he loses youth, he drips with the rain, he follows modern trends, but not forgetting his own cultural values and heritage.

But more than this, he lives with other people and his closeness to them is the unity of our nation that our flag signifies both in times of crisis and peace.

The flag as an insignia is convenient for countless reasons, among them, its distinct peculiarities. It can be woven into various shapes and in different colors. It can be so painted according to the political, social, cultural and economic forces of the nation it seeks to represent.

It can be raised to any height like the Filipino life must be raised. And it must be handled with care as the greater national interest must be handled and protected with care. This makes that piece of colored cloth the strongest unifying force for a people and a nation.

Loyalty to the flag, therefore, means loyalty and genuine regard for the national weal and security and dedication to the general welfare.

The flag hangs above us because the interest of our people must soar over the interest of the individual. And the flag flies because with it flies the hopes and aspirations of our people for the best in life now and in the future.

In fine, to ridicule the national anthem is downright rebellious and unkind. It is flagitious, so to say. It brings disdain and dishonor to our flag. It erodes the foundation of our inviolable institutions and everything we hold so dear as a sovereign country and people!

# A HISTORY OF

## TALIBA LODGE NO. 165

In the last decade of the 19th century, Freemasonry in the Philippines became a rallying point of many currents of discontent which it did not espouse, and a center for organized propaganda for political ideals it did not create. It is perhaps in this context that historian Teodoro A. Agoncillo observed in a speech before the Scottish Rite Masons on August 25, 1956 that the Philippine Revolution, viewed from a certain perspective, "may be said to have been the child of Philippine Masonry - an unwanted child perhaps, but a legitimate child nonetheless."

A history of Taliba Lodge lends substance to the observation. This Lodge produced the founders of the *Katipunan* and some of the principal supporters of Rizal's *Liga Filipina*. It is also its members who carried over into the *Katipunan* society the symbols, ceremonies and organizational structure of Masonry and breathed into it Masonry's climate of freedom.

Taliba Lodge was established in Trozo, by members of Nilad Lodge, and like most other Lodges engen-

dered by Nilad, it begun as a *Triangulo* or Masonic Club. Extant Masonic documents indicate it was in existence as early as April 1892, but it was only on November 8 of the same year that it was issued its charter as Lodge No. 165 by the *Gran Oriente Español*. Incidentally, its first officers under charter were: Venerable Master, Jose Dizon (Masonic name, *Montgomery*); Senior Warden, Eustacio Javier (*Tagalog*); Secretary, Jose Reyes Tolentino (*Prim*); Orator, Modesto Español (*Año*); Treasurer, Cirilo Gregorio Cuejilo; and Expert and Master of Ceremonies, Epifanio Saguil (*Tibu*)

Taliba was born in perilous times, on the eve of the Revolution against Spain. Within a few months after its organization, Bro. Jose Rizal returned to the country, and his visit precipitated a minor wave of persecution of Masons. The authorities, suspecting Rizal of subversive activities, kept a close watch over his movements and those with whom he was in contact, and as he associated mostly with Masons, this resulted in the discovery of a few Lodges and the subsequent deportation of some Masons, among whom

were: Doroteo Cortez of Bathala Lodge, Leon Apacible, founder of *Triangulo* Kalumpang, Antonio Roxas, Jose Basa Enriquez, Ambrocio Salvador and Vicente Reyes. The members of Taliba Lodge, therefore, had to take elaborate precautions to keep their activities from the watchful eyes of Masonry's intransigent enemies. To avoid detection, they constantly changed the situs of their Lodge sessions and for a time met "under the celestial canopy" in groups of not more than three.

At the start, the personal dangers which membership in the Fraternity brought with it did not act as an appreciable deterrent to the growth of Taliba Lodge; it only purified its membership by discouraging the entry of ambitious adventurers, the curious, and those who normally join organizations for private gain.

We learn from a former member, Antonio Salazar, that in spite of the persecutions, the membership of Taliba Lodge steadily grew and in fact became so large it was decided in July 1893 to divide it into two. Hence, Antonio Salazar (*Selabis*), Domingo Guason (*Langam*), Jose Reyes Tolentino (*Prim*), Epifanio Cuisa (*Dagoberto*), Valentin Polintan (*Bamboche*), Modesto Espanol (*Agno*), Anacleto Reyes and others left Taliba to found a new Lodge, *Modestia* Lodge No. 199. In time, however, the deepening political crises which the country faced stalled the growth of Taliba Lodge. The heightened-surveillance mounted by the authorities made proselytizing difficult and the holding

of meetings next to impossible. Moreover, more and more the loyalty and attention of the members of Taliba Lodge was channeled towards revolutionary activities.

Perhaps it can be said that the seed which led to the death of Taliba was planted in April 1893 when Andres Bonifacio of Taliba Lodge, Domingo Franco of Balagtas Lodge and others revived the *Liga Filipina* which had withered away after the rustication of Rizal in Dapitan in July 1892. The new *Liga* was divided into popular councils with a Supreme Council at the top. All the councils formed were headed by Masons, to wit:

- (1) Supreme Council - President, Domingo Franco (*Felipe Leal*) and Secretary, Apolinario Mabini (*Katabay*) both of Balagtas Lodge.
- (2) Binondo Council - President, Estanislao Legaspi (*Azul*) of Lusong and La Integridad Española Lodges.
- (3) Quiapo Council - President, Bro. Francisco Nakpil; Treasurer, Bonifacio Arevalo (*Harem*) of Balagtas Lodge.
- (4) Tondo Council - Timoteo Paez (*Raxa Matanda*) of Lusong Lodge in Tondo.
- (5) Ermita and Malate Council - President, Ambrocio Flores (*Musa*) of Bathala Lodge in Ermita.
- (6) Sampaloc Council - President, Numeriano Adriano (*Ipil*); Members - Moises Salvador (*Araw*), Apolinario Mabini (*Katabay*), Andres Bunda (*Ampon*), Domingo

Franco (*Felipe Leal*) all of Balagtas Lodge in Sampaloc.

- (7) Sta. Cruz Council - President, Isaias Toribio (*Salakot*) of Nilad Lodge.
- (8) Trozo Council - President, Andres Bonifacio (*Sinukuan*); Secretary, Teodoro Plata; Treasurer, Epifanio Saguil (*Tibu*); Members, Alvaro Nepomuceno (*Juarez*), Jose Reyes Tolentino (*Prim*), Jose Trinidad, Luis Villareal (*Balisa*) and Jose Dizon (*Montgomery*), all of Taliba Lodge.

At this point it may be pertinent to point out that the *Liga Filipina* was, in the words of Bro. Jose Rizal, organized "on the basis of Masonic practices". A fundamental rule of the Masonic Fraternity prohibits its adherents from involving the Craft in political controversy. The Filipino leaders of Masonry respected this non-political injunction, but at the same time they must have been aware that in the 18th and early 19th centuries, many conspiratorial secret societies in Europe owed much of their success to their adoption of Masonic structures, procedures and rules of secrecy. They must have known of such secret organizations like the *Carbonari*, *Illuminati*, the *Sublimes Maitres Parfaits* or Sublime Perfect Masters, the *Raggi*, the *Lega Nera* and a host of others which mushroomed in Europe, all of which were patterned after Masonry. Indeed the Masonic initiatory rituals, the use of secret recognition signs, the oaths of secrecy, and the adop-

tion of symbolic names fitted nicely into the needs of secret political societies. The founders of the *Liga* must have also seen the wisdom of borrowing Masonic practices for the *Liga* so they acted accordingly. Later, the resultant structural similarity between Masonry and the *Liga*, and for that matter with the *Katipunan* Society, misled the authorities into confusing the three organizations. Furthermore, subsequent discovery that the same group of persons led all three strengthened the conviction that they were in fact essentially united. Hence, Masons came to be considered *ipso facto* subversives and the authorities felt perfectly justified in suppressing the Fraternity.

By far the most active of all the popular councils of the *Liga Filipina* was the one at Trozo, headed by and composed of members of Taliba Lodge. So successful was the Trozo council in recruiting members from the masses it was felt that if an election were held Bonifacio could have easily wrested control of the association. The activities of the members of Taliba in the *Liga Filipina* of course had its toll on their Masonic obligations. As they intensified their work for the *Liga* their time for Masonic labors was correspondingly reduced.

In October 1893 a controversy brought about the final dissolution of the *Liga Filipina*. Those who still nourished the hope that political reforms could be peacefully obtained from Spain banded together under an organization called *Cuerpo de Compromisarios*, while those who were convinced that an armed uprising was the only solu-

tion to the political ills of the country grouped themselves under the banner of the *Katipunan* under the leadership of Taliba Lodge members, Bonifacio, Plata and Jose Dizon. The *Katipunan*, like the *Liga*, was structurally similar to Masonry - the initiatory rituals, recognition signs, oaths of secrecy, use of symbolic names, organizational separation of units, all very familiar to Masons, were all used in the *Katipunan*.

Before long Bonifacio and his companions devoted most if not all of their time to the *Katipunan* to the neglect of Taliba lodge. After this date little is heard of the Masonic activities of Bonifacio. All the writer could find is a claim made by Pablo de Palma of Luzong Lodge that in 1895 a Lodge of Sorrows (Sesion Funebre) was held in his house in Palompong presided by Apolinario Mabini, with the assistance of Ambrocio Flores, Ambrocio Bautista Reanzares, Andres Bonifacio as Orator, Teodoro Plata as Secretary and himself as Temple Guard.

By 1896, Taliba Lodge became dormant. Antonio Salazar testified that earlier that year he received information that *Taliba* Lodge no longer held meetings because its Venerable Master Jose Dizon and Andres Bonifacio were engaged "in the affairs of the *Katipunan*". Later that year, the Revolution broke out and a reign of terror was unleashed by the Spanish authorities which definitely caused the demise of Taliba Lodge. A great majority of its members were arrested and some were executed, while those who escaped arrest were in the field

fighting the Spaniards. Its Venerable Master, Jose Dizon, and Senior Warden, Luis Enciso Villareal, were arrested and executed on January 11, 1897 along with former member Antonio Salazar. Aniceto Avelino (*Cuvier*), Modesto Español (*Agno*) Epifanio Cuisa (*Dagoberto*), Alvaro Nepomuceno (*Juarez*), Valentin Polintan (*Bamboche*), Valentin Diaz, Epifanio Saguil (*Tibu*), and Jose Reyes Tolentino (*Prim*) were all arrested. Even Jose Turiano Santiago who had moved over to *Modestia* Lodge and was expelled from the *Katipunan* by Bonifacio for alleged treason did not escape arrest. Bereft of members, Taliba Lodge had no choice but to fold up.

Even after peace returned to the country Taliba Lodge remained dormant. For ten long years its beehive of workers did not meet. Then on New Year's day in 1907 some surviving members of Taliba Lodge along with Brethren from other Lodges met at 229 Diaz St., Manila and agreed to reestablish the Lodge. They set its revival for January 11, 1907, the day which marked the 10th anniversary of the martyrdom at Bagumbayan Field of Bros. Jose Dizon, Luis Enciso Villareal, Antonio Salazar, Domingo Franco, Moises Salvador, Numeriano Adriano, Faustino Villaruel and others. At the meeting they also provisionally designated the following as its officers: Venerable Master, Epifanio Saguil; Senior Warden, Alvaro T. Nepomuceno; Jr. Warden, Epifanio Cuisa; Orator, Proceso Santos; Secretary, Teodoro Gonzales, Treasurer, Bernabe Bustamante; and First Expert, Jose T. Santiago.

In compliance with Article 199

of the Statutes and General Regulations of the *Gran Oriente Español*, which requires a Lodge under organization to hold three meetings on separate dates before it can be legally formed, the members met anew on January 6, and confirmed the officers elected in their previous meeting. The following day, January 7, 1907, the Brethren met for the third time and in accordance with Article 293 of the Statutes and General Regulations elected the following as the regular officers of the Lodge: Venerable Master, Epifanio Saguil; Sr. Warden, Jose T. Santiago; Jr. Warden, Alvaro Nepomuceno; Secretary, Teodoro Gonzales; Treasurer, Bernabe Bustamante; First Expert, Agapito del Rosario; Master of Ceremonies, Aniceto Avelino; Temple Guard Valentin Diaz, and Revising Architect, Francisco Barreto. The duly elected officers were then installed on January 11, 1907. Among those who attended were Valentin Polintan, Grand Delegate to the Philippines of the *Gran Oriente Español*; Carlos Pombo, Master of Dalisay Lodge; Timoteo Paez, Master of Sinukuan Lodge and representatives of Lodges Dalisay No. 177, Sinukuan No. 272, *Modestia* No. 199, Nilad No. 144, Walana No. 158, Luzong and the other Lodges under the *Gran Oriente Español*.

On March 15, 1907 the reorganization of Taliba Lodge was formally approved by the *Gran Oriente Español* and on May 30 of the same year, it was officially constituted in ceremonies held in the Lodge hall of Dalisay Lodge in 85 Sta. Rosa St., Manila.

Inspite of its auspicious begin-

ning, the revived Taliba Lodge had a shaky existence, and barely four years after its resurrection it again disappeared from the Masonic scene. Because of reverses it was fused with two other Lodges, Balagtas and Luzong Lodges, to form a new Lodge, *Solidaridad* Lodge No. 323, named after the pioneer Lodge in Madrid.

Some ten years after its second "death" Taliba Lodge was again revived, but this time under very different circumstances. Earlier, in 1912, the Grand Lodge of the Philippines Islands was organized and some five years later the members of the Spanish Lodges affiliated with it *en mass* resulting in the dissolution of all the Lodges under the *Gran Oriente Español*. The *Gran Oriente Español*, however, did not accept the loss of its Lodges with placid complacency. On July 17, 1919 it authorized Mariano Tenorio to reorganize its lodges in the Philippines. Tenorio must have applied himself to his task with exceptional zeal for by 1922 he had succeeded in reorganizing six old Lodges and setting up three new ones. Among the reorganized Lodges was Taliba Lodge No. 165.

The re-establishment of the Lodges under the *Gran Oriente Español* was viewed by the Grand Lodge of the Philippine Islands as an unwarranted invasion of its territorial jurisdiction and it considered the Lodges so organized as clandestine. Thus, Taliba Lodge No. 165 was deemed clandestine by the Grand Lodge of the Philippine Islands and remained so until it was dissolved shortly after its second re-birth for the third and perhaps final time.

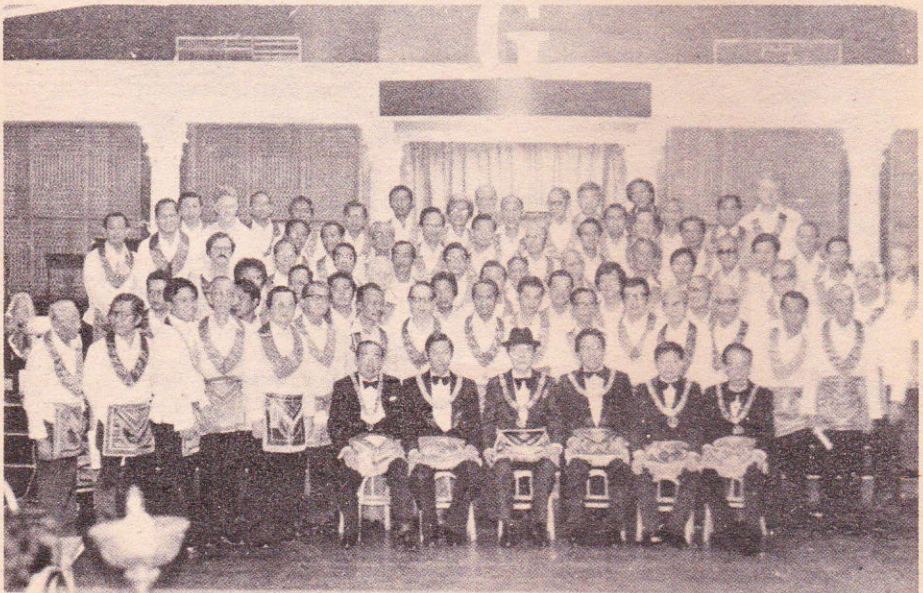

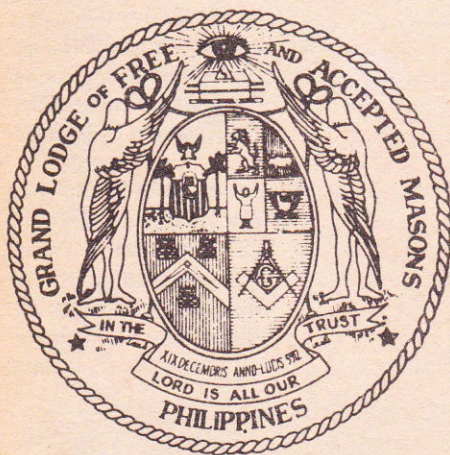
