MW REYNATO S. PUNO

GRAND MASTER OF MASONS

MW Reynato S. Puno is the third son of WB Isaac I. Puno, Sr. of Guagua, Pampanga and Narcisa Serrano of Penaranda, Nueva Ecija. He comes from a family known for its involvement with the Methodist Church and its commitment to the masonic fraternity. No less than seven in their family belong to Hiram Lodge No. 88. Four of them

(Isaac, Sr., Isaac, Jr., Leven and our MWGM) served as its Worshipful Master.

MW Puno is married to the former Luzviminda Tolentino Delgado of Bacoor, Cavite. Sister Luz is a lawyer on her own right, finishing her LLB degree in 1961, *cum laude* and as valedictorian of her class.

Their union is blessed with three children, Reynato, Jr., Emmanuel and Ruth.

MW Puno was born in Manila on May 17, 1940. At 44, he is the youngest Grand Master in the last 34 years of the MW Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of the Philippines.

MW Puno enjoys impressive academic credentials: Bachelor of Science in Jurisprudence, U.P. (1962); Bachelor of Laws, U.P. (1962); Master of Comparative Laws, Southern Methodist University, Dallas, Texas, (1967); Master of Laws, University of California, Berkeley, California, (1968) and finished all academic requirements of Doctor of Juridical Science, University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, in 1969.

As an undergraduate student in U.P., MW Puno was one of its outstanding student leaders in the tumultuous decade of the sixties. He served as Editor-in-Chief of the *Philippine Collegian*, official weekly student newspaper of UP, (1960-1961); Chairman, Editorial Board, the *Law Register*, official student newspaper, UP College of Law, (1960-1961); Recent Documents Editor, *The Philippine Law Journal*, U.P. College of Law and Asst. Editor-in-Chief of the 1962 *Philippinensian*, official graduate annual of U.P. He received the Outstanding

Student Award for Excellence and Leadership given by the Alpha Phi Beta fraternity of the UP College of Law in the years 1960-62.

As a graduate student of law, MW Puno distinguished himself in academics. He was a full scholar of the Academy of American Law of Dallas, Texas; a full scholar of the Walter Perry Johnson Foundation of Berkeley, California; and a partial scholar of the University of Illinois. He obtained the degree of Master of Comparative Laws (M.C.L.) with high honors and as the valedictorian of his class consisting of 23 graduate scholars from various parts of the world. He won the American Jurisprudence Prize in five (5) subjects: Comparative Private International Law, US Constitutional Structure, International Organization, Problems of Doing Business Abroad and Commercial Law. The prize is given by the Lawyers Co-operative Publishing Co. of New York and the Bancroft Whitney Publishing Co., of California.

After his graduate studies, MW Puno readily established his mark in the legal profession. He engaged in the general practice of law, first with the Gerardo Roxas & Abraham F. Sarmiento Law Office and then with the late Judge Isaac S. Puno, Jr.; became a law professor; served as Bar Examiner, and authored numerous articles which were published in different law journals and periodicals.

In 1971, MW Puno responded to the call of public service by accept-

ing an appointment as Solicitor in the Office of the Solicitor General. The 70's witnessed the most momentous constitutional cases litigated in the Supreme Court. MW Puno had the opportunity to participate as counsel in these transcendental cases where the government prevailed. At 32, he was designated as Acting City Judge of Quezon City, the youngest at that time. At 33, he was named Assistant Solicitor General with the rank of a judge of the Court of First Instance, again the youngest to hold such position. At 40, he was elevated Associate Justice of the Court of Appeals. At 43, he was again ap-

pointed Appellate Justice of the new Intermediate Appellate Court. Until now, he carries the distinction of being the youngest justice of the country.

MW Puno has been bestowed with some of the most prestigious awards in the country. Among others, he has been chosen as a TOYM awardee in the field of law; Outstanding Prosecutor of the Philippines by the PC-CIS; Outstanding Citizen of Quezon City; and included as one of the 1000 distinguished citizens of the Philippines in 1980.

MW Puno's masonic career is just

as checkered. He was raised in Hiram Lodge No. 88 on May 1, 1964; elected as its Worshipful Master in 1976; appointed Grand Orator of the Grand Lodge in 1978; served as District Deputy Grandmaster of District No. 1 comprising Metro Manila in 1979; elected Junior Grand Warden in 1981-82, Senior Grand Warden in 1982-83 and Deputy Grandmaster in 1983-84. For the past several years he has been chairman of the Grand Lodge Committee on Jurisprudence and Committee on Revision of the Constitution. He is also the Philippine representative to the MW Grand Lodge of Oregon, U.S.A.

MW Puno is equally active in the appendant masonic bodies. In the Scottish Rites, he was coroneted 33° IGH in 1983 and is at present the Venerable Master of Luzon Bodies A, & A.S.R. In the Royal Arch Luzon Chapter No. 1 he was

greeted as a Royal and Selected Master, Luzon Council No. 9, R. & S.M. and dubbed Knights Templar in Luzon Commandery No. 9, K.T. He has been elected to the ASOKA Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine. He is also a member of the Royal Order of Scotland and a Noble of the Aloha Temple, A.A.O.N.M.S. Last but not the least, he is a member of the Supreme Council of the Demolay, and recipient of the Award of the Legion of Honor of the International Supreme Council of the Order of Demolay.

Like all the members of his family, MW Puno is a pillar of the Methodist church. He has served the Knox United Methodist Church in various capacities: Chairman of the Board, Lay Leader and Trustee. He is one of its Lay Speakers frequently invited to expound the Living Word in many of its pulpits all over the country.

More Light in Masonry, More Light from Masons

Tonight, we ring down the curtain on our 68th Annual Communication. Many an eye and ear were on us during all the time that we were holding our 3-day communication. The reason is easily perceivable. Since the tremors of turbulence started to be felt on our doorstep, many have watched how masons will contend with the crisis. As time marches on and as the circles of crisis kept widening, masonic watchers have stopped merely photographing our posture. Now in increasing decibels, some decry our low, almost invisible profile with the piercing question: Where are the masons today?

It is understandable why some of our countrymen tend to look for masons whenever they are shaken by the convulsions of a crisis. Without any whit meaning to blow our own trumpet and beat our own drum, it is the masonic fraternity that has supplied our country with an unbroken line of heroes whenever there were good fights to be fought. A sidelong glance at our mausoleum of heroes will readily

reveal that it is bedecked with masonic names: Rizal, Bonifacio, Aguinaldo, Del Pilar, Mabini to specify a few. To be sure, our masonic heroes did not cease to labor after winning battles after battles for the freedom of our people. The country owes to them as well those different substructures erected to assure that our people will enjoy enduring peace, progress and prosperity. Manuel Quezon, Manuel Roxas, Jose Abad Santos etc., are all masons whose contribution to our country in its time of peace can well match the contribution of others when it was embroiled in war. But if the tree of liberty in the Philippines was nurtured by the lives of masonic martyrs, the field of freedom in other countries have been similarly fertilized by the blood of other masonic heroes. Indeed, the history of freedom in any part of the world is but the story of the lives of masonic heroes. Let us not therefore be neither irritated nor agitated when during hours of crises, the

search light is directed on the masonic fraternity.

I say that the masons of today should not avoid the shaft of that searching question: Where are the masons today? And I submit that there is no way to respond to this question except strictly in accord with our timeless tenets and tested teachings. To us masons, this is and ought to be a proposition too plain to invite the heat and passion of argument. But the texture of the time has made the task a tricky one. From without our lodges, we are beset by the imposition of political, economic and social innovations that disturb many of our once immutable beliefs. And even from within our ranks, we hear the twangs of tongues purveying disparate approaches to these innovations. Our sense of the situation is even befuddled by confusing calls, coming from non-masons who try to pull masonry to positions which range from the anemic to that of the activists, who try to push masons from the sideline to the battle line. The result is confusion, a disquieting one.

The requirement of the time is for every mason to imbibe every basic syllable and all the intricate polysyllables of our masonic faith.

I maintain that only those with finger tip familiarity of our touchstone tenets can save the fraternity away from the wayward route. Only masons who immensely immerse themselves in the imperishable principles of masonry can lead and be a light to other men. And only among masons whose hearts have been soaked in our tenets can we hope to find the resurgence of that blood that flowed in the veins of our heroes.

Prescinding from these premises, I have picked the theme "More Light in Masonry, More Light from Masons" for this masonic year. In line with this theme, I have also chosen as the centerpiece of our program, the thorough dispersal of masonic knowledge in the heart and mind of every mason. This thrust demands the revamp of our old system of masonic education. We have to discard fragmented approaches and band aid solutions to the problems posed by our inadequate level of masonic learning. After consultation with some of our ablest minds in the fraternity today, I have decided to establish a Center for Continuing Masonic Education. The different dimensions of the thrust of this program will be conceptualized and crafted by our Grand Lecturers, an Executive Director and a board to be composed of brethren who have distinguished themselves in the field of education like university and college presidents, deans and ranking officials of the Ministry of Edu-

cation and Culture. The Center will have special divisions on history, jurisprudence, symbolism, ritualism and a separate library and museum. I have asked the brethren who will man this Center to design modules which will enable the members of the Craft to study masonry in the privacy of their homes. If they have to be styled as correspondence courses, so let it be. But it is imperative that we reach the greatest number of our members, especially those who have not been very active in lodge activities. They are the core of our constituency and yet heretofore we have not seriously brought to them the boons of masonic education. It is time to shift our attention to these brethren instead of concentrating our efforts on the few who always attend lodge meetings, seminars and conventions. These latter brethren are the interested, knowledgeable and committed kind. I say let us now look on the other kind: the stay home variety, the too busy type, those with too little a time for masonic activities. I agree with the thinking that we will sink or swim depending on how successful we can motivate them.

The Center will also start an honest to goodness library and archive that will house the latest masonic publications of other Grand Lodge jurisdictions as well as our own. It will furthermore undertake an exhaustive commentary on our Masonic Law Book. We shall be conscripting for this



purpose the talents of our legal luminaries. It will also be the task of the Center to update our history book whose recording of our history stopped in the 1920s. I will ask the Cabletow and the Lodge of Research to synchronize their activities with the Center. They must more effectively perform their primary role as conduits of education. If I am committing the resources of the Grand Lodge to this effort, it is because I believe in the rhapsody of the poet who wrote: ignorance is the curse of God and knowledge the wing wherewith we fly to heaven. I hope that in this year we can kindle an educational renaissance among the brethren. After all, I view masonry as the purposeful pursuit of the light of truth.

Even while we have carpentried a comprehensive program of masonic education, let me assure you that we have not neglected to give a macro view of the other problems of the Craft. Among others, we are

going to give the program of our youth, especially the DeMolays a big push; we shall rationalize the jurisdictional set up of the Shriners; and this year, too, we shall establish a national organization for our Past Masters. I wish to honor our past masters not with semantics but with a structure that shall take care of their concerns.

The continuation of the construction of our new Temple needs special mention. Despite the valiant efforts of our PGMs, we are still far away from our target. Our deepening economic crises has aggravated this problem. But we cannot pause on our efforts. This year, we have to finish the roof of our temple. That roof alone will cost us a cool million. If the cost is shocking, the penalty of failure is more alarming. We stand to lose to the elements all that we have so far constructed. If therefore we have to contract an obligation to construct that roof we shall not hesitate to do so. The construction of the roof is the key move. After that comes the completion of the halls. We have a strategy for this none other than to ask some of our more capable masonic organizations and groups to put up the money for the halls, give them the right to indicate the decorative motif of the hall, name the hall after them, and in addition

give them corresponding office spaces in the new temple. This way we can have a York Rite Hall, a Shriner's Hall, a Mindanao Hall, a Visayan Hall, etc. We shall then have a temple with halls expressing motifs of different masonic bodies and islands of our country. To top all this, we shall be sponsoring a series of concerts in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao where our blue lodges are strongest. It is our hope that the proceeds of the show will go a long way in shifting the burden of the cost of the new temple away from our rank and file of our brethren.

After a long and serious consideration, let me also announce that I intend to make major moves in two sensitive areas. The first area is the need to institute reforms on our electoral process. Before we get destroyed by the degeneracy of electoral malpractices like other less fortunate organizations, it is time to take a no nonsense look at our own failures. I shall soon be creating a commission with complete powers to study our electoral system and propose reforms for its purification. Among the areas that it will dissect on its own and with the help of our blue lodges are the following: (a) the desirability of continuing the practice of the PGMs recommending nominees for the position of JGW; (b) the advisa-

bility of abolishing district nominations for the position of DDGM; and (c) the need for establishing an independent COMELEC with ample powers to enforce all laws, rules and regulations designed to safeguard the sanctity of our elections.

I posit the thesis that it is time that we entrust the strict enforcement of these laws, rules and regulations on brethren who are not involved in politics. I maintain the proposition that brethren occupying political offices cannot be fearless in the task of enforcing our election rules because they are encumbered by the favors they have received. On my part I am willing to subordinate the position of Grand Master to any independent COMELEC in the matter of protecting the sanctity of our election. I know that this is a tall order. But let not the past shackle our future. Let us forget where we have failed and let us remember that it is not too late to succeed. If the fraternity has been strong as an oak, it is because we have adhered to the principle of "who best can work and best agree." We can not allow that bedrock principle to be eroded by electoral malpractices. We shall endlessly regret it because it will spell the end of the Craft.

Last but not least, I intend to tackle our problem of absenteeism by its horns. For so long a time, we have tolerated brethren from absenting themselves in lodge meetings despite their contrary obligation. Let us now blow the whistle

on these invisible brethren. Unless we do so now, we are courting the danger that the problem will assume an epidemic proportion. I believe that we shall not be weakening the Craft by dropping off these absentee members. Let us despair when we lose devoted members, but we need not be rendered disconsolate by the loss of the disinterested. I agree that he is not a true mason who refuses to share the joys of fellowship with the brethren in his lodge; he is not a brother who does not miss the strength of the cabletow of brotherhood within his lodge; indeed, he is not a brother who does not savor the dew of harmony inside his lodge. And so, this year, I will issue an edict mandating every mason to attend at least three (3) stated meetings in a year on pain of losing his good standing in his lodge. I will leave it to the Worshipful Master to determine who shall be excepted from the rule due to excusable grounds. The Worshipful Master shall have the authority to mete out the appropriate penalty on erring members. Let me say that in issuing this edict we shall only be giving teeth

to the obligation that we took. Let us not allow any brother to tamper with his obligation.

I will not tarry any longer. The road ahead this year will be rough and rugged. We therefore seek your patience, your understanding, your sympathy and your helping hands. Let us always remember that as masons we seek to serve not ourselves but others, we seek no reward except the satisfaction of selflessness. Let me end by quoting

what one masonic writer wrote:

We can't all be heroes
And thrill a hemisphere
with some daring adventure
But we can fill a lifetime
with kindly acts and true
There's always noble service
for noble souls to do.

Right Worshipful Pedro W. Guerzon, the newly installed Deputy Grand Master, was born in Intramuros in 1927 and is married to Charo Viray-Guerzon with whom he has two daughters. He now lives in Cagayan de Oro City. He is a BSC graduate of FEU. Presently, he is the distributor of Basic-Landoil Energy Corporation for Misamis Oriental, Bukidnon, and the cities of Iligan, Surigao and Butuan. He is the President of Three “G” Distributors, Inc., a franchised dealer with recapping plants in Cagayan de Oro City and Ozamis City and furthermore operates the Licoan Basic Service Station in Cagayan de Oro City.

RW Guerzon was raised in Davao City Lodge No. 149 in 1962 and is a charter member of Macajalar Lodge No. 184 wherein he became Master in 1971. After serving as GLI for two years, he was appointed DDGM for District No. 17 and during his incumbency he helped organize several lodges. In 1982 he was elected Junior Grand Warden, and in 1983, Senior Grand Warden.

RW Guerzon joined the Mindanao Bodies, A & ASR in 1965. In 1975 he became as KCCH and four years later was coroneted 33° IGH. Presently he is the Deputy for Mindanao Bodies. He is also a charter member of the Advisory Council of Wadish Saab Chapter, IOD, and is a Past Worthy Patron of the Order of the Eastern Star.

Aside from his Masonic affiliation, RW Guerzon is active in the YMCA and the Lions Club. He is a past Lions Governor of District 301-E and has represented the local Lions Club in some international Lions Conventions. He is also recipient of medals and citations for his activities as a Lion.

The third highest ranking officer of the Grand Lodge of Free & Accepted Masons of the Philippines is RW Reynold S. Fajardo, the Senior Grand Warden.

The Past Grand Royal Patron of the Order of the Amaranth was Editor, *The Cabletow* (1981-1982) and was Associate Editor, *Far Eastern Freemason* (1981). He served as Grand Lodge Inspector, Junior Grand Lecturer and District Deputy Grand Master for District No. 9; and Junior Grand Warden.

For Masonic Year 1984-1985, RW Fajardo is on the following Grand Lodge Committees: Committee on Administration of Lodges, Committee on Awards, Committee on Budget, Committee on Buildings and Masonic Temples and the Committee on Charity & Investment.

Initiated in Quezon City Lodge No. 122 in 1971, he affiliated as a dual member of with Manila Mount Lebanon Lodge No. 1.

He is the Chief Citizens Attorney of the Citizens Legal Assistance Office (CLAO) of the Ministry of Justice, a position he has held since

1975.

An alumnus of the University of the Philippines where he obtained his Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree in 1955, he attended the 10th Session of the Career Executive Service Development Program of the Development Academy of the Philippines.

In 1979 he was Philippine Delegate to the Conference on Legal Development, Jakarta, Indonesia; Delegate to the Asean Law Association 2nd General Assembly, Kuala Lumpur, 1982; In the same year (1982) he was a Lingkod Bayan awardee for his "outstanding and significant contributions to public service" as determined by the Career Executive Service Performance System (CESPES).

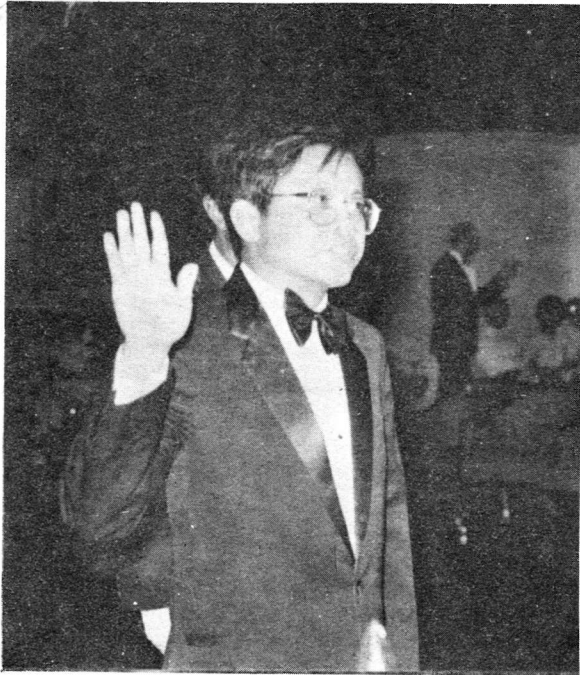

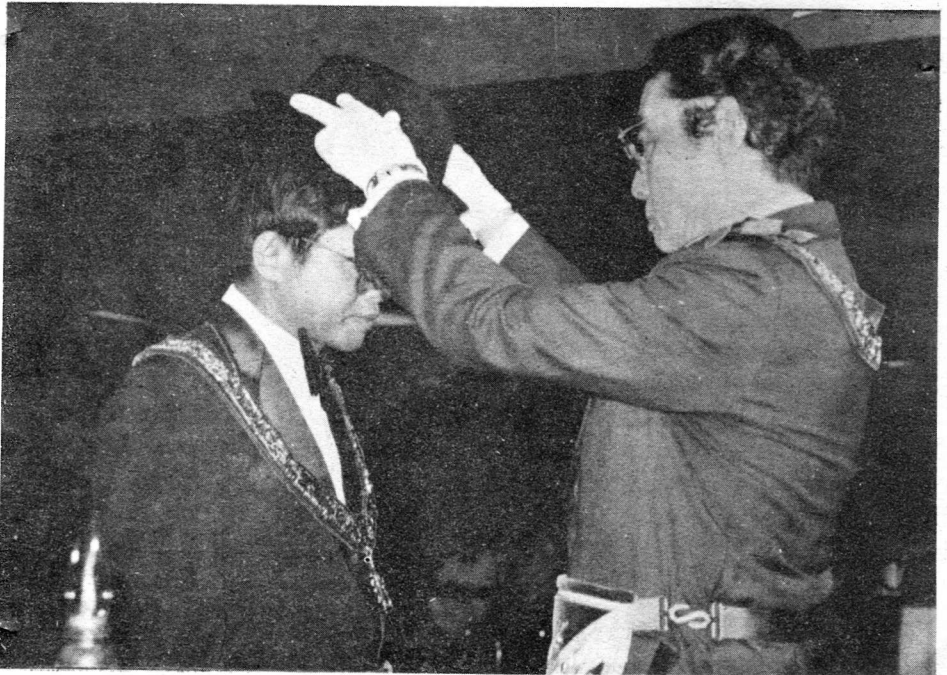

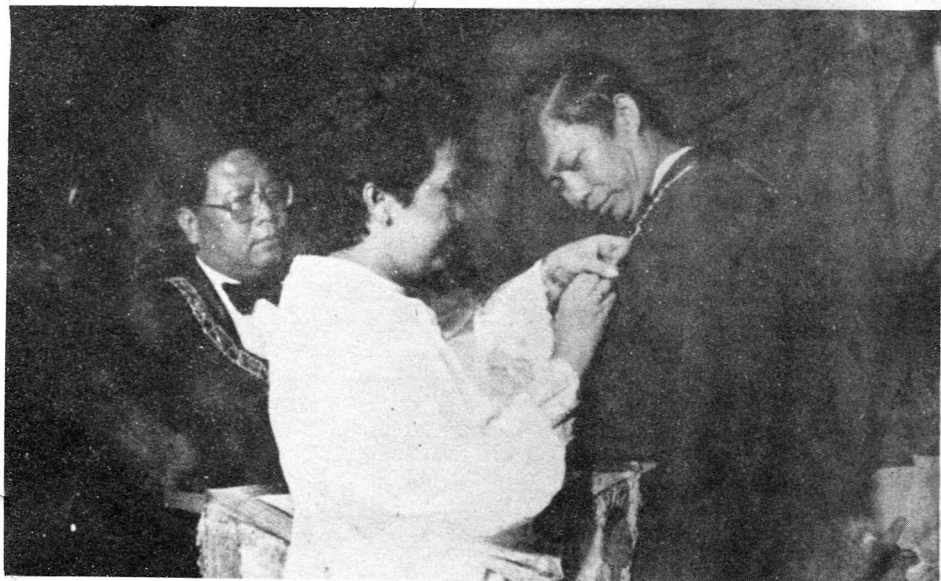

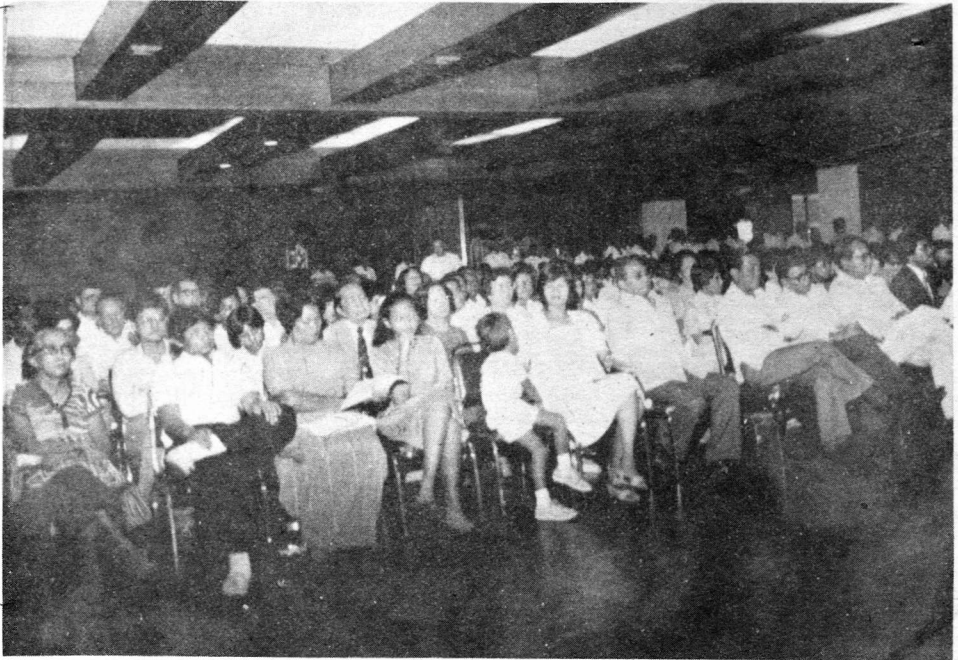

EDICT NO. 81

To all Masters, Officers
and Members of Lodges
under this Jurisdiction:

Whereas, our blue lodges have long been plagued by the unjustified absences of some of their members;

Whereas, our blue lodges will be irreversibly weakened by these unjustified absences which if allowed unchecked will have a contaminating influence over other members;

Whereas, masons have the obligation to attend the meetings of their blue lodges where they can best imbibe our tenets and experience brotherly love;

Whereas, the sanctity of our obligation will be meaningless if its unjustified transgressions will not be penalized.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, REYNATO S. PUNO, Grand Master of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of F. & A. M. of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers in me vested by the Constitution, do hereby promulgate and decree that any mason who unjustifiably

fails to attend at least three (3) stated meetings of his blue lodge within twelve (12) months starting July 1, 1984 shall be subject to suspension; Provided, however, that the brother concerned shall be summoned and be given an opportunity to explain his absences; Provided further, that it shall be the Worshipful Master who shall determine (a) whether or not the absences are due to justifiable reasons and (b) the duration of the suspension, in case penalty is appropriate. The decision of the Worshipful Master shall be appealable to the MW Grand Master.

CIRCULAR NO. 1

Series of 1984 – PUNO

TO: ALL DDGMs, DLGs, MASTERS AND OFFICERS OF SUBORDINATE LODGES GRAND LODGE OF THE PHILIPPINES, F. & A. M.

Whereas, one of the bedrock principles upon which the strength of the fraternity rests is "who best can serve and best agree."

Whereas, to give realism to this ideal, our Constitution prohibits "any member, directly or indirectly, to provide food, accommodation, entertainment, or any other means to solicit for himself or for any other Mason, an elective or appointive office in the Grand Lodge."

Whereas, it is the consensus of the brethren that it is high time to reexamine our electoral mechanism to protect the purity of our Grand Lodge election of officers;

Whereas, unless there is an assurance that our elections shall not be vitiated by malpractices we cannot attract the best qualified among the brethren to serve the Grand Lodge;

Whereas, unless we safeguard the

sanctity of our electoral processes, the Craft stands in clear danger or degenerating into another organization usually rend asunder by divisive politics;

Whereas, it is perceived that one of the greatest threats to our harmony today are un-masonic elections;

WHEREFORE, I, REYNATO S. PUNO, Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons in the Philippines, hereby order:

- (a) All blue lodges to devote at least one stated meeting to discuss how we can institute reforms on our electoral processes and to submit their recommendations to the Grand Lodge not later than October 30, 1984;
- (b) All district conventions to include as an item in their agenda proposed reforms in our electoral processes and to forward their findings and recommendations to the Grand Lodge within fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of their conventions.

Among other areas of concern, I urge the following to be the subject of an in-depth study: (a) whether or not it is advisable to

have our PGMs nominate three brethren for the position of JGW; (b) assuming its advisability, whether or not this PGMs system of nomination can be stand improvement; (c) whether or not district conventions should continue to suggest names for the position of DDGMs (d) whether or not it is necessary to create an independent COMELEC with ample powers to enforce our election laws, rules and regulations.

In the DDGM-DGL Workshop held in Manila last June 23, 1984, it was brought out that the decretal portion of Edict No. 81 is receiving varying interpretations by the brethren and hence, there is need for an official, clarificatory bulletin.

Be it therefore known that Edict No. 81:

(a) Simply requires every mason in this jurisdiction to attend at least three (3) stated meetings in a year. Contrary to some interpretations, it does not require attendance in nine (9) stated meetings in a year. The attendance in said three (3) stated meetings need not be successive.

(b) The only penalties that can be imposed on erring members are warning, reprimand, or suspension with a definite period; hence, there is no need to draw out a mechanism for reinstatement.

Let this interpretative bulletin be read in open lodge at the stated meeting next following its receipt and shall be recorded in the minutes.

Bulletin No. 2

To: All DDGMs, DGLs, Masters

In the DDGM-DGL Workshop held last June 23, 1984, an interpretation was sought of par. 3 Edict No. 60 – Tria which provides

“3. That an Entered Apprentice shall not be passed and a Fellowcraft shall not be raised unless at least 14 days have elapsed since his taking the preceding degree;”

i.e., whether an Entered Apprentice who proves himself proficient in the catechism, including the required examination, can be passed without waiting for the lapse of fourteen (14) days from his initiation.

The query should be answered in the negative. Paragraph 3 which requires the lapse of fourteen (14) days before an Entered Apprentice can be passed and a Fellowcraft

can be raised is mandatory in character. In fact, Par. 7 of the same edict provides that non-observance of the fourteen (14) day period “shall subject the officers to disciplinary action.” The rationale for the fourteen (14) day rule need not elude us. The interval is necessary for the Entered Apprentice and the Fellowcraft to imbibe the variegated ramifications of our tenets as progressively taught in degrees. It also affords the members of the Craft further opportunity to determine whether the candidate deserves to be raised on the basis not only of his proficiency but his moral qualifications.

Grand Master sets Guidelines for DDGMs and DGLs

1. DDGMs should act as real alter egos of the GM in their districts. There should be no hesitation to exercise the powers and assume the responsibilities inherent and incident to the office. Problems within the district should be resolved by them with the least dependence from the GL.

2. Each DDGMs is *required* to develop a year long program of activities for his district. The program should respond to the peculiar problems of the lodges in the district, of the brethren and the local community. The program should be relevant and realistic. As the ones familiar with the ambience of your district, you are in the *best position* to fashion out this program. A uniform program for all districts is unworkable for each district has its own variables. It is also presumptuous.

3. Be that as it may the following steps are suggested to be taken *immediately*, viz:

a) *Form a council of elders* in the district to serve as advisers. The members should enjoy the

respect of the district, preferably past masters and past DDGMs and lecturers.

b) Have a *written profile* of every lodge in your district. The profile should be *exhaustive* and *reliable*. It should pinpoint the strength and weakness of each lodge in terms, among others, of proficiency of its officers, attendance of members, financial condition, etc. The profile can be given by the inspector assigned to the lodge. Using the profile you can then assist the lodge concerned with its program.

c) Have a *written profile* of your district. Among others, the profile should contain an assessment of the *state of masonry* in your district. Depending on this state, fashion out a program for the district. You may consult the GL for this purpose. You are to report to the brethren in your district convention how well you were able to carry out your program. The same report should be given to the GL.

d) You should immediately prepare the list of proficient and available brethren who are to serve as inspectors of the lodges in your district. Consult with your Lecturer, council of elders and masters. The list should be ready by April 28 so the corresponding appointment can be extended.

e) Inform the GL of the date of your convention, constitution of lodges, etc. so they can be calendared with the least of conflict on their dates. Conventions should have a similar format. Our theme for the year is "more light in Masonry, more light from Masons." The convention should feature:

1. State of the District Address by the DDGM
2. Report of the WM of each lodge
3. Report of the GL to be given by the MWG or representative
4. Assessment of the reports by the convention.
5. Other reports can be asked from CABLETOW, ACACIA, MHCC, DeMolay, etc. These related organizations should be given all possible assistance.
6. Awards should be given to

- a) outstanding lodge
- b) outstanding master
- c) outstanding masons in

f) Develop a small list of professionals in your district (lawyers, doctors, businessman, engineers, government officials) who can assist the brethren when necessary. The list can be expanded later on.

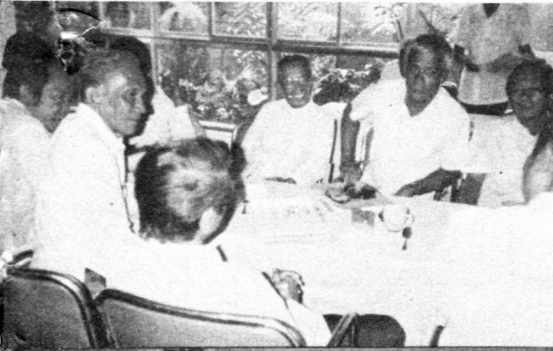
