It is our responsibility as members of the community, especially as Freemasons, to help in alleviating the plight of the less fortunate. We have the means to do it.

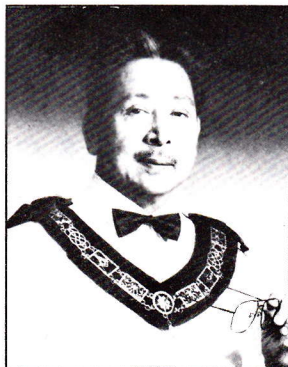

They are making a difference for Freemasonry. They are practicing the tenets of our Craft outside the Lodge. They bring glory to our Brotherhood by helping others.


If these brethren can do these humanitarian deeds, you can do them, too.

The Masonic Doctrines of Del Pilar

On the 142th birth anniversary of Marcelo H. del Pilar which falls on August 30, we feature in the Editorial the doctrines that guided him in his Masonic life.

Our object is to diffuse the light of civilization and make known to all the needy of worthy sentiments, cultured manners, affability, and untrammelled intelligence in all our actions.

Freemasonry is not a mutual aid society. Mutual protection forms part of its program: every Mason is obliged to protect his brethren. This, however, is not its main objective. Its ideal is much loftier. It is to strive for the brotherhood of man. Hence, it stands for democratic government and upholds the real and effective autonomy of human individuality against that boundless ambition which thrives by absorbing the rights of the people and waters its happiness with the tears of the needy.

The duties of man are twofold: duties towards his Creator and duties towards humanity. Religion takes care of the former and Freemasonry of the latter. We do not

encroach upon the field of religion; our goals are different. The relation which we cultivate and strive to perfect is not that between man and God but that between man and humanity.

We admit in our ranks all men regardless of what their religious beliefs may be, because in each human intellect and in the manifestations of its religious consciousness, the Mason respects the sparks of divine light and does not discuss them or profane them by meddling interference.

We do not side with any religious sect. The wars, assassinations, and burnings at the stake in the name of religious principles, by which humanity has been shocked, the blood shed in the name of the diverse deities, of their conflicting attributes, and of deified objects, have not stained the apron of the Mason but have shown its purity, making it a banner of peace in the midst of the cruel struggles of religious intolerance.

We respect the various religious creeds; we do not trouble the peace of honest consciences, and we treat with pity and tolerance those whose intolerance renders them incompatible with the beliefs not only of the Masons but of the rest of the community. The God of Love must not be made a source of hatred between men.

The perfection of humanity is not possible unless man is free; hence, social institutions, political bodies and political ties are justifiable and can exist only when their aim is the defense and protection of liberty.

Copies of past Grand Lodge Proceedings and of the pre-war **Cabletow** reveal that there were more Lodge resolutions passed during Ancoms than edicts issued by Grand Masters. Elected Lights then considered Lodge resolutions to be of utmost importance.

But since the advent of multi-district conventions the Committee on Resolutions, by and large, has discovered a dearth of Blue Lodge resolutions that are so encompassing

as to merit its consideration.

Thus, it came to pass that during Ancoms the brethren spent more time approving edicts than resolutions. Does this presuppose that we are ruled by edicts?

Certainly, there's nothing the matter with edicts. It's a Grand Master's privilege to issue edicts **when the Ancom isn't in session**. When the Ancom is in session, the elected Lights legislate.

So, in practice, at certain Ancoms, members of the Grand Lodge are reduced to approving edicts.

Good Service Isn't Free

The best things that are God-given are free, but the next best things that we humans can avail of are expensive.

Good is costly. Evil is equally costly.

Life is free. But to keep life moving, pulsating, vibrant and meaningful may cost a fortune.

Time was when **The Cabletow** was a corporation. But it was dissolved as such because some brethren did not fare well as stewards of the same. In effect, the choice of

the editorial staff of **The Cabletow** for each term fell into the hands of just one individual—the incoming Grand Master. This practice subjects the intellectual competence of the writers to their personal attachments and loyalties.

When **The Cabletow** was a corporation, the editorial staff was elected by the membership. The editors did not depend on one person's personal choice.

The fiscal management of **The Cabletow** is presently in the hands of the Grand Lodge. And you know what? What is being spent for the printing and mailing of copies of **The Cabletow** and for honoraria is part of the budget of the previous Grand Master. So, the increase in the subscription rate of our official publication, which Grand Master Mateo campaigned for, will be enjoyed by the incoming Grand Master.

Since 1983, **The Cabletow** has not had a permanent editorial staff because the staff's term is co-terminus with that of the Grand Master. Result? The inconsistent direction of **The Cabletow**.

This Masonic year, as editor-in-chief, I had to start from scratch. I'm happy, nonetheless, that I have a progressive Grand Master who feels that the money we have isn't enough for a well-edited, balanced editorial format. **The Cabletow** has ceased to be a one-man show. Members of the editorial staff have commendable track records.

But, how free is free? How long can charity go?

I suggest that the brethren resolve the problem of **The Cabletow** in their district conventions. I dare them to be wise in this regard.

MANUEL L. QUEZON: Father of Philippine Independence

MLQ was the first Filipino Grand Master in Freemasonry, and his being so helped the Philippines gain independence from the United States.

Brilliant, dynamic, charismatic, volatile, decisive, impulsive, and fearless—these are the adjectives historian Teodoro Agoncillo used in describing Manuel Luis Quezon, Senate President and later President of the Philippine Commonwealth.

Born on August 19, 1878, Quezon died on August 1, 1944.

In his lifetime, Quezon blazed a trail of fierce nationalism and dynamic leadership.

The enactment of the Philippine Autonomy Act or Jones Act in the U.S. Congress in 1916, among many other achievements, is credited to Quezon. Quezon, then the Philippine Resident Commissioner, lobbied in and out of the U.S. Congress for its approval. The Act gave Filipinos an elective Senate, greatly increased Philippine autonomy, and in its preamble expressed the sentiment that Filipinos should be given early independence.

When Quezon was elected Senate President as a consequence of the Jones Act, he continued to pursue the independence of our country. On June 13, 1919, U.S. House Bill No. 5719, declaring the Philippines free and independent was filed.

Quezon did not achieve these successes single-handedly. His being a member of Freemasonry opened gates to him in Washington which

before were closed to Filipinos. He dealt with Freemasons in the highest echelons of the U.S. government who gave him full hearing and ensured that their brethren from the Philippines and their cause received full justice.

Quezon was raised to the Master Mason degree in Sinukuan Lodge on May 23, 1908. He was elected the Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of the Philippines in 1918, the first Filipino to hold this lofty rank. Previously, only Americans were elected Grand Masters.

Prior to his ascendancy to the highest position in Philippine Freemasonry, Quezon as Deputy Grand Master was instrumental in uniting Filipino Lodges under the Grand Lodge of the Philippines.

The political fortunes of Manuel L. Quezon turned for the better when he struck a special relationship with Francis Burton Harrison, then the Governor-General of the Philippines.

Harrison, a pro-Filipino American Governor-General, joined Freemasonry in the Philippines in 1916. When he rose to higher degrees shortly thereafter, he chose to become a member of the Philippine Bodies group instead of the one established for Americans.

In his speech before a meeting of Masons, Harrison spoke of unity:

"I expect to see from this time on a more complete fraternity and unity between the two peoples in these Islands. Now, what is the best medium for bringing that about? Why, through this very order of high-minded, right-thinking, splendid patriotic men."

Harrison, the Governor-General, and Quezon, the Senate President, the two most powerful men in the country, were the best of friends. Both were extremely active in the affairs of Freemasonry inside and outside of the Lodge.

The gates of Malacañang Palace were opened to Filipino Masons. The

site where once Spanish Governor-Generals plotted against Masonry was converted into a Masonic meeting place.

Towards the end of 1918, Quezon left for the United States as head of the first Philippine Independence Mission to Washington. With him was a large group of Masons which included Conrado Benitez, Rafael Palma, Emiliano Tirona, Teodoro Yangco, Quintin Paredes, Jose Abad Santos, Camilo Osias, Maximo Kalaw, and Arsenio Luz.

Quezon's mission was converted into a Masonic odyssey. He was swamped with invitations to Masonic functions. Being a Grand Master, Senate President, and eloquent speaker, he was much sought-out by Grand Lodges and regular Lodges in America.

No doubt, Quezon's Masonic contacts in the United States helped him in his official mission. Masonry was an "open sesame" causing doors which would have otherwise remained closed to swing open. The Masonic grip was a strong one and broke down resistance where others failed. The numerous Masons in both Houses of the U.S. Congress extended all their help and cooperation.

Thus, a year after, Rep. William E. Mason of Garfield Lodge 689 filed House Bill No. 5719 — a bill declaring the people of the Philippines free and independent. In the hearings of the Committee on the Philippines, two Masons, Senator Warren Harding, who later became President of the United States, and Rep. Horace Towner, treated Quezon and the members of his mission with utmost courtesy.

The man whom American Masons fondly called "Casey" made his mark not only in Philippine history, but also gained the respect and admiration of great men in the United States of America. ▲

Tyranny attempted to stifle freedom of thought and its manifestations, the right to assemble, and other aspirations of social life; but tyranny found itself face to face with Freemasonry which has become a personification of the universal protest against the designs of tyranny.

While enthroned tyranny has been scheming how best to strike off the head of all humanity at one blow, Freemasonry dedicates its efforts to the tasks of making all men brothers, wiping out all differences of nation, race, and color, abolishing war, and replacing the clash of arms and of chains by the joyous din of labor and industry.

In the Philippines, Freemasonry is the brain that must do the thinking for our people. We must strive to establish, if not in our laws, then at least in our popular custom, love of liberty, equality, and fraternity. Let our Lodges study problems of organization, be it

economic, political, military, commercial, or what not. Let each member state his ideas or deliver lectures on his particular line of activity and training, the merchant on commerce, the farmer on agriculture, the soldier on the art of war, etc. What we need is habits of discipline, habits of collective life.

As regards the exercise of Masonic charity, our practice is to look for the needy who hide their poverty, bringing the succor of Masonry to their homes and giving them to understand that such aid comes from a body of men who do not wish their benefactions to be known because they do not ask for the gratitude of the beneficiary nor do they impose any conditions for the granting of such relief, so that regardless of the religious beliefs professed by him, or whether or not he goes to confession, communion or mass, his distress will be relieved because he is entitled to relief. ▲

Announcing to the whole world our virtue is pure ego-tripping, attention-arousing, downright un-Masonic.

That has been our stand. But quite thin is the dividing line between informing the public and doing propaganda. Propaganda is what any institution wants to dish out. A propagandist devotes himself to spreading a system of principles. Information, on the other hand, is what the public wants to know. To inform, says the Home Study Dictionary, is to inspire or give life to; to actuate with vitality; to communicate knowledge to; to instruct; to acquaint or appraise a person of something.

For years Masonry has been the object of derision and the subject of debate among "experts" who claim to know the esoteric and exoteric tenets of the Fraternity. Frequently its mem-

bers have been condemned in high places and even in the **sanctum sanctorum** of religious fanatics. But Masons have kept their peace. They have serenely let the world go by. They have let events take their course as if the Masons' Gibraltar is forever.

Where, many have asked, are the Masons?

They are, of course, around. Silent. Almost.

Our Grand Master has challenged us to come out into the open and be counted. It is high time we emerged from our enclaves and actively participated in non-political, non-religious issues that concern our national life. Let us be in the vanguard of the movement of letting Truth conquer everything. ▲

"You know," said MW Osias, then Senate President Protempore, "the phrase and so forth is a very useful phrase. When you do not know anything more, just say and so forth and your listeners think you know more even if you don't."

But, seriously, the proposed compilation, which may be used as a reference book, if not as a textbook, in the elementary level will contain, among other things, MW Osias' "decatalogue" which reads as follows:

2. Love our country and be loyal to our people.

4. Obey the laws and respect the Constitution.
5. Be honest and truthful in thought, in word, and in deed.

7. Strive to be clean, chaste, and pure.

a great extent, influenced by Masonic philosophy and phraseology. Needed: Unity and Pride

Walana Lodge 13 – 100 Years



LEGISLATURA DE 1915

Walana Lodge 13 played a major role in the struggle for freedom of our country against the Spaniards and Americans.

Within the decade of its founding, it fought the Spanish colonizers and tried to dislodge the American invaders from the Philippines.

It metamorphosed from Logia Walana 158 which was organized in February 1892 under Grande Oriente Español. Its charter was issued on May 2 of the same year. It became Walana Lodge 13 when it joined the Grand Lodge of the Philippines in 1917.

Faustino Villaruel founded Walana assisted by Marciano Reyes, Tranquilino Torres, and Cipriano Castillo.

Significance of Its Name

“Walana” is the Tagalog term for “that which has been lost”, which symbolizes a Master Mason’s search for life’s unfathomable meaning.

Later the term assumed another nuance.

At that time Masons were suspected by the Spanish authorities to be enemies of law and state and their Lodges separatist societies, so that they were closely watched and their homes and temples frequently searched. A vigorous campaign against Masonry, moreover, was waged by the religious corporations.

In the face of all this, the members of Walana (or Walanians) circumspectly held their meetings, sometimes in WB Villaruel’s house on Calle Asuncion in Binondo and at other times on Calle Azcarraga. They also posted watch-outs nearby. When the civil guards were in the vicinity, the watch-outs would give a signal for the brethren to cease their Masonic labors and be on their guard. The brethren would resume their meeting upon hearing the watch-outs shout “Walana!” (implying that the civil guards were gone).

**Villaruel: Apostle of
Masonry, Martyr of
Bagumbayan**

The organizer and first Worshipful Master of Logia Walana No. 158 was a well-to-do citizen of Pandacan, Manila and an enterprising businessman. Symbolically, he was *Ilaw* (light). He was also described by MW Teodoro M. Kalaw, PGM, as "an indefatigable apostle of Masonry."

He initiated the movement for a better central organization of Masonry in the Philippines, which led to a general assembly of Lodges held at his house in Binondo on April 16, 1893 and presided by him.

That assembly definitely constituted a Grand Regional Council (GRC) and elected her officers, among whom were two Walanians: WB Faustino Villaruel, Grand Second Vice-President, and Isidro Villaruel, Grand Almoner.

The formation of the GRC, Grand Orator-elect Apolinario Mabini stressed, was ". . . of exceptional transcendence to Philippine Masonry and a glorious deed to its initiator."

WB Faustino Villaruel is credited for the founding of the *Triangulo Vanguardia* in Hongkong and the Adoption Lodge, an auxiliary Lodge for women, approximately a year later.

He, furthermore, involved his family in Masonic affairs. His own beautiful and civic-spirited daughter Rosario was the first members of Adoption

Lodge. She was initiated on July 18, 1893, with the symbolic name of *Minerva*.

Ilaw travelled to different parts of the country making an intensive propaganda campaign for his beloved Fraternity. In Tarlac, with the help of Jose Sofio Bañuelos and Procopio Hilario, he transformed *Triangulo Agosto* into Lodge Villaruel No. 223. He worked with Isabelo Artacho and several other brethren in firming up Masonry in Pangasinan. He and fellow Walanian Enrique Escuardia went to Aparri, Cagayan, where they helped Gracio Gonzaga and Fermin Makanaya in founding Minerva Lodge No. 217.

In 1894, he founded Lodge Patria in Cavite.

In 1895, despite incalculable risks, he continued his self-imposed mission of strengthening Masonic unity and spreading Masonry.

But the Katipunan was exposed to the Spanish authorities on August 19, 1896. This development forced the Lodges to dissolve and to burn their documents and other materials. Trapped in the cities and towns, many Masons were either shot or sent to exile. A greater number took to the field to meet their persecutors in real battle.

On August 20, WB Villaruel and fellow Lodge leaders Antonio Salazar, Luis Enciso Villareal, Domingo Franco, Jose Dizon, Moises Salvador, and Numeriano Adriano were arrested, allegedly because Masonic documents were found in their possession. They were subjected to inhuman tortures, then pronounced guilty of treason and insurrection in a mock trial, and finally, on January 11, 1897, executed in Bagumbayan.

"Martyr of Bagumbayan" Faustino Villaruel, in his own measure, was ILAW to his Fraternity and country.



**Elias Asuncion:
Walanian-Turned-
Revolutionary/Reorganizer**

Jacinto Ocampo, Isidoro Ablaza, Elias I. Asuncion, Manuel M. Tolentino, and Placido Limanoc were among the Walanians who joined the armed struggle against the oppressive, abusive, repressive colonizers. They also took active part in the reorganization of Walana Lodge, which took place in the temple on Calle Ylaya, Tondo, Manila on August 26, 1906, with the help of the three Lights of Sinukuan Lodge No. 272, namely: Timoteo Paez, Pablo Herrera, and Lucio Buzon.

Of these brethren, Elias I. Asuncion stood out.

A 3rd degree member of the KKK, he joined Walana August 19, 1895.

Exactly a year later he was with Andres Bonifacio during the "Cry of Balintawak." Then, together with Valentin Diaz and several others, he marched from Manila to Pandacan, where they waited for other comrades, such as Placido Limanoc, Artemio Ricarte, Emilio Jacinto, Lucio Buzon, and Guillermo Masangkay.

Next, on orders of Bonifacio, he left for Ugong, Pasig to take charge as Secretary General of Zone No. 2, which had jurisdiction over the towns of San Juan del Monte, Mandaluyong, San Pedro Macati, Baranca, Suabuy, Balara, Balintawak, Pasong Baliti, and Pasig.

In February 1897, he was summoned to Calumpit, Bulacan to serve

as Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo's adviser.

Transferred to the column of Gen. Pio del Pilar, 2nd Lt. Elias Asuncion took active part in all operations north and south of Manila.

As a result of the signing of the Pact of Biak-na-bato, he was sent to Hongkong together with Mariano Llanera, Gregorio del Pilar, Vito Belarmino, Salvador Estrella, and others.

After a two-week sojourn in that Colony, he was sent back to Manila to reorganize Revolutionary Companies.

When the American forces occupied the City of Manila in May 1897, he joined the Manila Battalion, the 3rd Company of which he served as 2nd Lieutenant.

Later, in recognition of his courageous services, he was promoted to the rank of Captain.

But in a fierce battle against the Americans in Mangatarem, Pangasinan, he was wounded on the right leg and taken to Manila as prisoner of war.

After the Philippine-American War he was set free together with Valentin Polintan, Dr. Maximo Viola, Fr. Francisco de los Reyes, and J.N. Nepomuceno.

In March 1901 he worked as bodega annotator in the Q.M.D. In September 1902, however, his loyalty suspected by the American authorities, he was imprisoned anew and deported to Olongapo. In December of that year, he was set free.

On February 27, 1904 he was wrongly charged by Fiscal Gale of the crime of sedition and conspiracy against the US Government in the Philippines. Fortunately, the Judge of First Instance found him innocent and ordered his release from prison.

In 1906 he zealously served as Junior Warden of the reorganized Walana. In 1908 he was elected Worshipful Master. From 1910 to 1912 he was Lodge Secretary. In 1913 he was again elevated to the Oriental Chair.

WB Elias Asuncion was also Representative of Walana to the Regional Grand Lodge of the Philippines and to the Board of Friendship put up by different Lodges for the purpose of ironing out conflicts and harmoniously realizing their noble objectives.

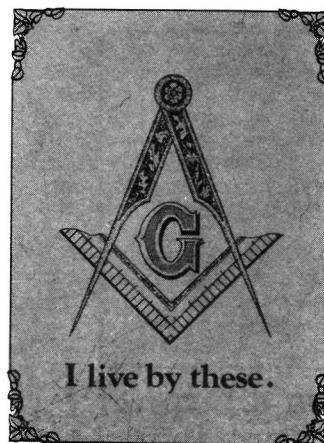
A Final Word

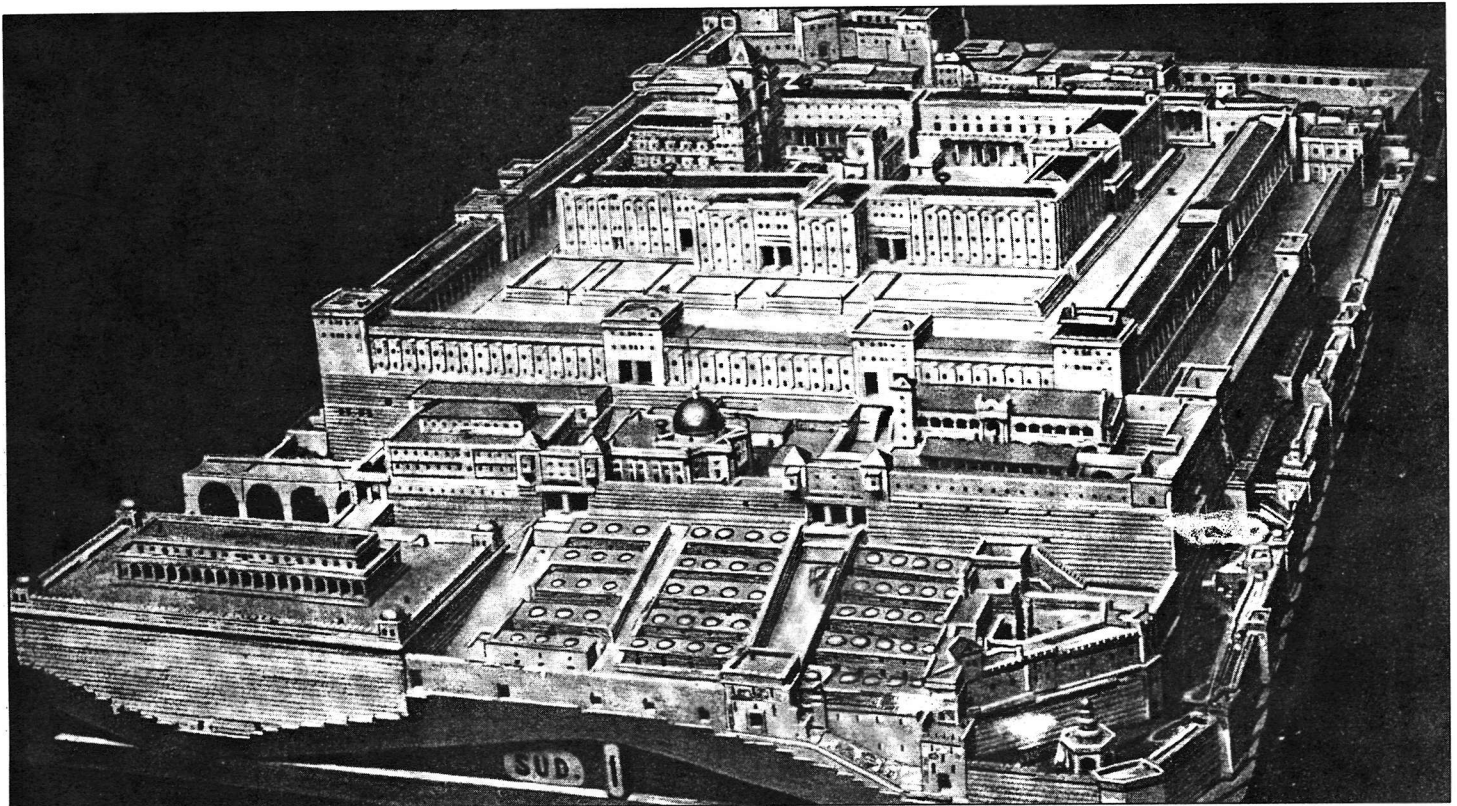

The Symbolism of Solomon's Temple



Temple of King Solomon

Albert G. Mackey states that the Operative Art is symbolized, i.e., used as a symbol, in the **Speculative Science to meet its objectives**. This brief essay will try to illustrate how this is done in reference to a system of symbolism dependent for its construction on types and figures derived from the Temple of Solomon, which may be referred to as the “Temple Symbolism of Freemasonry,” and in so doing will touch on the “elementary symbols” of the Order, which are the primary and important aspects of the study of the philosophy of the Craft.

Bearing in mind that Speculative Masonry dated its origin from the building of King Solomon's Temple, an earthly and material temple, dedicated to the service and worship of God, Speculative Masons symbolize these labors of our ancient brethren in the construction of a spiritual temple in our hearts, pure and spotless, fit for the dwelling place of him who is the author of purity – where God is to be worshiped in spirit and in truth, and whence every evil

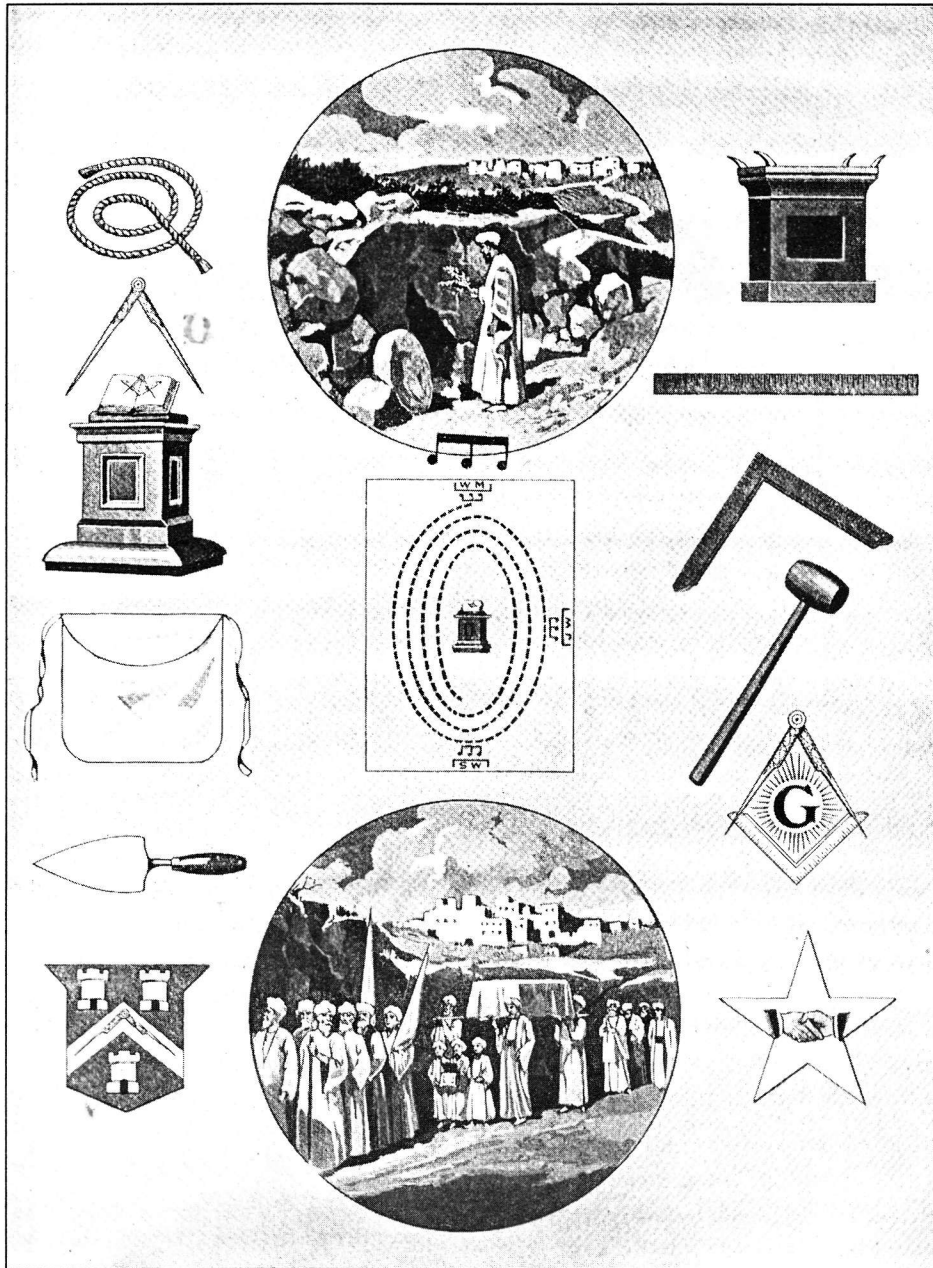
This spiritualization of King Solomon's Temple is the first, the most prominent and most pervading of all the symbolic instructions of Freemasonry. It is the link that binds the operative and the speculative arts of the Order. It is this which gives it its religious character, for temple worship is in itself an ancient type of the religious sentiment in its progress towards spiritual elevation.

To further illustrate the method in which the Speculative Masons have appropriated this design of King Solomon to their own use, let us discuss the entire construction, although briefly, of the temple.

To construct his earthly temple, the Operative Masons followed the architectural designs laid down on the "trestle-board", or book of plans of the architect. By these he hewed and squared his materials; by these he raised his walls; by these he constructed his arches; and by these strength and durability, combined with grace and beauty, were bestowed the edifice he was constructing.

The "trestle-board" becomes, therefore, one of our elementary symbols. For in the Masonic Ritual the Speculative Mason is reminded that, as the operative artist erects his temporal edifice, in accordance with the rules and designs laid down on the trestle-board of the master workman, so should he erect that spiritual building, of which the material is a type, in obedience to the rules and designs, the precepts and commands, laid down by the Grand Architect of the Universe, in those great books of nature and revelation, which constitute the spiritual trestle-board of every Freemason.

The trestle-board is then the symbol of the natural and moral law. Like every other symbol of the Order, it is universal and tolerant in its application; and while, as Christian Masons, we cling with unfaltering integrity to that explanation which makes the Scriptures of both dispensations our trestle-board, we permit our Jewish

thought and unruly passion is to be banished, as the sinner and the Gentile were excluded from the sanctuary of the Jewish Temple.

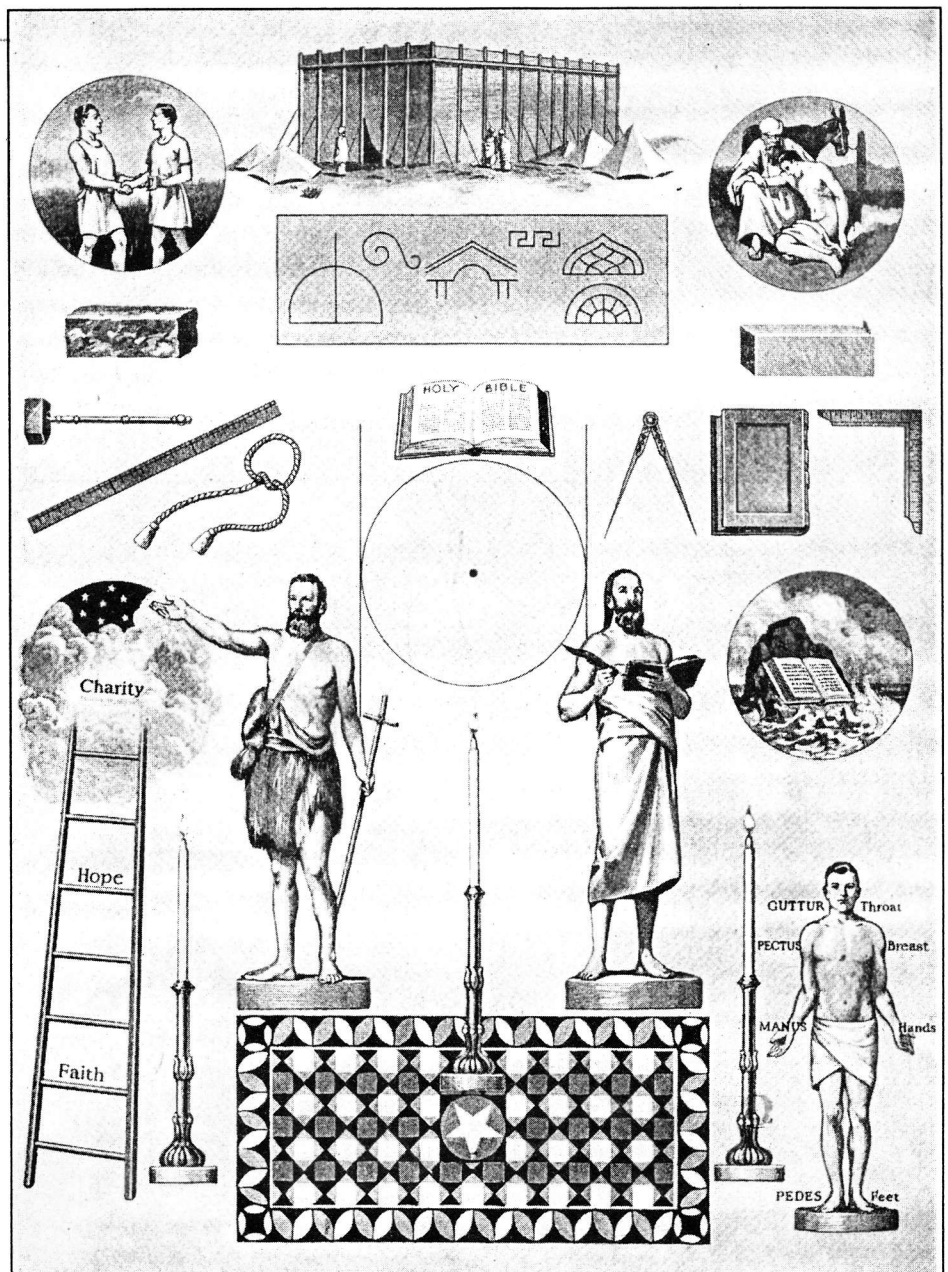
and Mohammedan brethren to content themselves with the Books of the Old Testament, or the Koran. Masonry does not interfere with the peculiar form or development of anyone's religious faith. All that it asks is, that the interpretations of the symbols shall be according to what each one supposes to be the revealed will of his Creator.

The Operative Mason required materials wherewith to construct his temple; the "rough ashlar" or the stone in its rough and natural state, unformed and unpolished, as it had been lying in the quarries from the foundation of the earth. This stone was to be hewed and squared, to be fitted and adjusted, by simple but appropriate implements, until it became a "perfect ashlar," or well-finished stone, ready to take its destined place in the building.

Again, in these materials do we find other elementary symbols. The rough and unpolished stone is a symbol of man's natural state - ignorant, uncultivated, and, as the Roman historian expresses it, "grovelling to the earth, like the beast of the field, and obedient to every sordid appetite"; but when education has exerted its salutary influences in expanding his intellect, in restraining his hitherto unruly passions, and purifying his life, he is then represented by the "perfect ashlar" or finished stone, which, under the skillful hands of the workman, has been smoothed, and squared, and fitted for its appropriate place in the edifice.

Here, an interesting circumstance in the history of the preparation of these materials has been seized and beautifully appropriated by our symbolic science. We learn from the account of the Temple, contained in the First Book of Kings, that "the house, when it was in building, was built of stone, made ready before it was brought thither, so that there was neither hammer nor axe, nor any tool of iron, heard in the house while it was in building."

This mode of construction, undoubtedly adopted to avoid confu-

sion and discord among so many thousand workmen, has been selected as an elementary symbol of concord and harmony - virtues which are not more essential to the preservation and perpetuity of our own society than they are to every human association.


The perfect ashlar and the mode of its preparation, taken together, is a symbol of the **social character of Freemasonry** - the attainment of **human perfection** and **concord** and **union** of men in society, another significant characteristic of the Order.

Both the Scriptures and tradition informs us that, at the building of King

Solomon's Temple, the operative masons were divided into different classes, each engaged in different tasks, namely: the bearers of burden, the hewers of the stones, and the overseers, called by the old Masonic writers as the "Ish sabal", the "Ish chotzeb", and the "Menatzchim". The same system of regulations has been preserved in our present day, or Speculative Masonry; they are the Apprentices, the Fellow Crafts and the Master Masons, who constitute an important and interesting part of temple symbolism.

Modern workmen who still pursue the same methods, as those from

the traditions of the Order have used few and simple tools in the quarries, namely, the twenty-four inch gauge, or two-foot rule, and the common gavel, or stone cutter's hammer. With the former implement, the operative mason took the necessary dimensions of the stone he was about to prepare, and with the latter, by repeated blows, skillfully applied, he broke off every unnecessary protuberance, and rendered it smooth and square, and fit to take its place in the building. Thus, in the first degree of Speculative Masonry, the Entered Apprentice receives these simple implements as emblematic of his profession, for the 24-inch gauge for him to measure no stone, but time, as a symbol of time well-spent or employed; and the common gavel for him not to smooth and polish stones, but to purify and cleanse his heart and mind from every vice and imperfection that would render it unfit for a place in the spiritual temple of his body, as a symbol of purification of the heart.

o resume the connected series of temple symbolism, we will now proceed at the time when the materials finished by the Apprentices were brought to the site of the building, where they were placed in the hands of another class of workmen, the Fellow Crafts, who correspond to the "Mystes" or the second degree of the ancient mysteries. At this stage of the operative work more extensive and more important labors were to be performed, and accordingly, a greater amount of skill and knowledge was required of those to whom these labors were entrusted. The stones prepared by the Apprentices were now to be deposited in their destined places in the building and the massive walls were to be erected. For these purposes implements of a higher and more complicated character than the gauge and gavel were necessary. The "square" was required to fit the joints with sufficient accuracy, the "level" to run the courses in a horizontal line, and the "plumb" to

erect the whole with due regard to perfect perpendicularity. And this portion of the labor finds its symbolism in the second degree of the speculative science, and in applying this symbolism we will continue to refer to the idea of erecting a spiritual temple in the heart.

The necessary preparation, then, having been made in the first degree, the lessons having been received by which the aspirant is taught to commence the labor of life with the purification of the heart, as a Fellow Craft he continues the task by cultivating those virtues which give form and impression to the character, just as adapted stones give shape and stability to the building. Hence the working tools of the Fellow Craft are referred, in their symbolic application, to those virtues. The "square" symbolizes morality- which teaches us to apply the unerring principles of moral science to every action of our lives, to see that all the motives and results of our conduct shall coincide with the dictates of divine justice, and that all our thoughts, words, and deeds shall harmoniously conspire, like the well-adjusted and rightly squared joints of an edifice, to produce a smooth, unbroken life of virtue.

The "plumb" is a symbol of rectitude of conduct- and inculcates that integrity of life and undeviating course of moral uprightness which alone distinguishes the good and just man. As the Operative Mason erects his temporal building with strict observance of that plumb-line, which will not permit him to deviate even a hair's breadth to the right or to the left, so the Speculative Mason, guided by the unerring principles of right and truth inculcated in the symbolic teachings of the same implement, is steadfast in the pursuit of truth, neither bending beneath the frowns of adversity nor yielding to the seductions of prosperity.

The "level," the last of the three working tools of the Operative Fellow Craft, is a symbol of equality of station, not that quality of civil or social posi-

tion which is to be found only in the vain dreams of the anarchist or the utopian, but that great moral and physical quality which affects the whole human race as the children of one common Father, who causes his sun to shine and the rains to fall on all alike, and who has so appointed the universal lot of humanity, that death, the leveler of all human greatness, is made to visit with equal pace the prince's palace and the peasant's hut.

In the Third Degree, the Master Masons of the modern science were known as the "Epopots" or the beholders of the sacred things in the ancient mysteries.

In this degree, the symbolic allusions to the temple of the Solomon and the implements of Masonry employed in the construction are extended and fully completed. At the building of that great edifice we have already seen that one class of the workmen was employed in the preparation of the materials, while another was engaged in placing those materials in their proper positions. Another class existed, a third and higher class, the master workmen – whose duty it was to superintend the two other classes and to see that the stones were not only duly prepared, but the most exact accuracy had been observed in giving to them their true juxtaposition in the edifice. It was only then that the last and finishing labor was performed, and the cement was applied by these skillful workmen. They secured the materials in their proper places, and united the building in one enduring and connected mass. Hence, the trowel, as we are informed, was the most important though, of course, not the only implement in use among the master builders. They did not permit this last, indelible operation to be preformed by any hands less skillful than their own. They required that the craftsmen should prove the correctness of their work by the square, level and plumb and test, by those unerring instruments, the accuracy of their joints; and, when satisfied of the just arrange-

ment of every part, the cement, which was to give unchangeable union to the whole, was then applied by themselves.

Hence, in Speculative Masonry the trowel has been assigned to the Third Degree as its proper implement, and the symbolic meaning which accompanies it has a strict and beautiful reference to the purposes for which it was used in the ancient temple; for as it was employed "to spread the cement which united the building into one common mass," so it is selected as the symbol of brotherly love – that cement whose object is to unite our mystic association in one sacred and harmonious band of brethren.

As the temple was then completed, so should we also complete our spiritual temple.

The stones having been hewed, squared, and numbered in the quarries by the apprentices, properly adjusted by the craftsmen, and finally secured in their appropriate places, with the strongest and purest cement, by the master builders, the temple of Solomon presented, in its finished condition, so noble an appearance of sublimity and grandeur as to well deserve to be selected, as it has been, as the symbol of that immortal temple of the body, to which Christ significantly and symbolically alluded when he said, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."

The idea of making the temple a symbol of the body is not exclusively Masonic; but the mode of treating the symbolism by a reference to the particular temple of Solomon, and to the operative art engaged in its construction, is peculiar to Masonry. It is this which isolates it from all other similar associations. Having many things in common with the secret societies and religious mysteries of antiquity, in this "temple of symbolism," it differs from them all. ▲

It harnesses members from all religious sects and work together in harmony without contradicting each other through "brotherly love, relief and truth". How could this be possible? Start knocking! If you come well-recommended and well-qualified then you can feel the efficacy of difference to answer the question of possibility.

the tenets of Masonry without conducting exhaustive investigation on the matter. Masonry is Masonry and the Fraternity is not opposed to or against any particular or total moral requirements of man and humanity.

The slogan at the beginning of the 20th century was progress. The cry at the end of the 20th century is survival. The call for the next century is hope. Together, brethren!



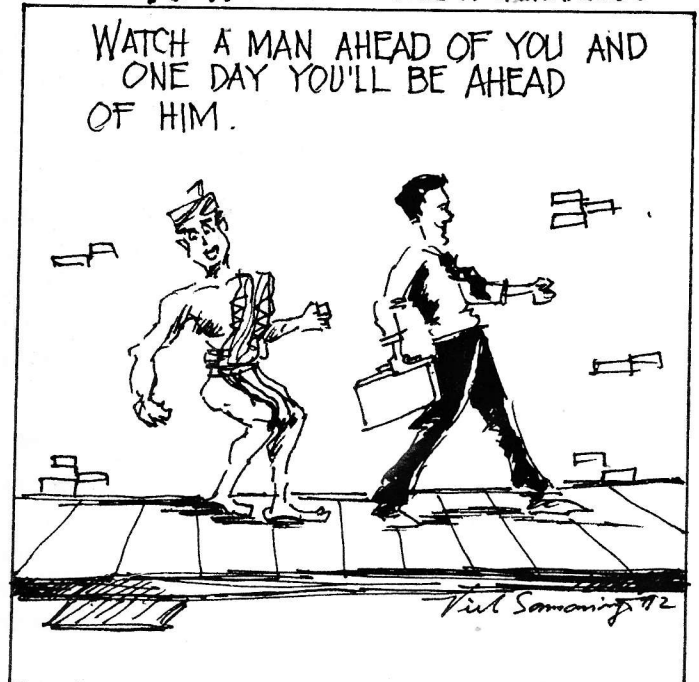

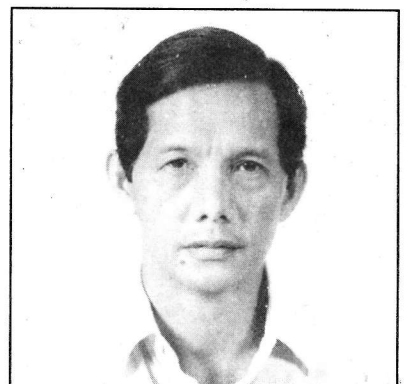

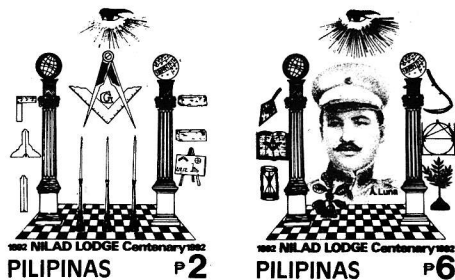

Masonic Stamps Issued



The Post Office issued last August 30 Nilad Lodge stamps commemorating the centenary of this Masonic lodge.

The set of three stamps features Marcelo H. del Pilar, Antonio Luna and the logo of Nilad Lodge. It tells of historic events at the turn of the century.

A hundred years ago, Filipino propagandists in Spain, including Rizal and many of our heroes, worked for reforms in their native land. They worked hand in hand with liberal Spaniards in many Masonic lodges. Marcelo H. Del Pilar, considered the

father of Philippine Masonry, decided to organize Masonic lodges for Filipinos in the country. Antonio Luna, among others, was entrusted with this task.

In time, the Nilad Lodge was chartered. From it, other Filipino lodges were formed. Philippine history records how these early Filipino Masons contributed, even the supreme sacrifice of life, to the independence of the country.

The Nilad Lodge stamps mirror the patriotic deeds of Masons of that era.

Temple for RP Shriners to be First Outside Americas

The construction of a Shriners Temple in the Philippines is expected to be approved soon, following the decision of the highest council of the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.A.O.N.M.S.) to "receive petitions" as a preparatory step next leading to that goal.

This was disclosed today by Philippine Shrine Association president Noble Rene R. Cruz, a top-ranking government official and civic leader, who said the Philippine Temple will be the Masonic concordant order's very first outside the Americas (now 191 in Canada, Newfoundland, Mexico and USA).

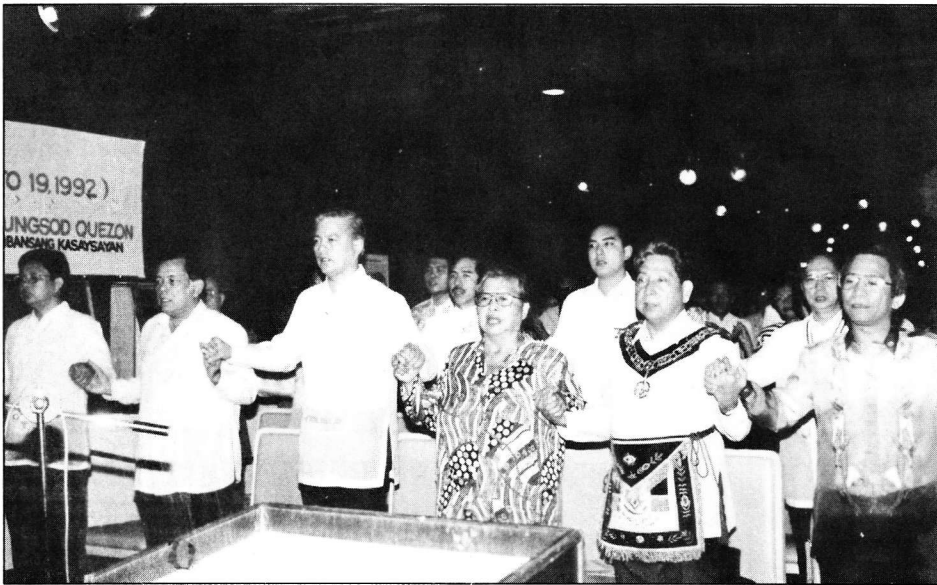
Cruz, a retired general and now vice chairman and executive officer of the National Police Commission, said the A.A.O.N.M.S. Imperial Council granted the receipt of petitions shortly after its June 29 annual national convention in Orlando, Florida.

The PSA leader credited the success of the Philippine initiative, after two earlier tries, to the "persuasive and sincere advocacy" of Noble Ed Murdock, secretary and past president, and Noble Joe Guerrero, Past Grand Master, who spoke in behalf of all Nobles in the Philippines before special committees formed by the Imperial Potentate.

Noting that in its last attempt, six years ago, the PSA faltered, Cruz said he has set the target at 500 signatures of Nobles in good standing as suggested by Imperial Recorder Jack Jones, adding that "we must not fail this time, for most likely this will be our last chance to have our own Temple in the Philippines."

The PSA office is in the Plaridel Masonic Temple, with Tel. 522-2328, and is open during regular office hours for member inquiries and assistance.

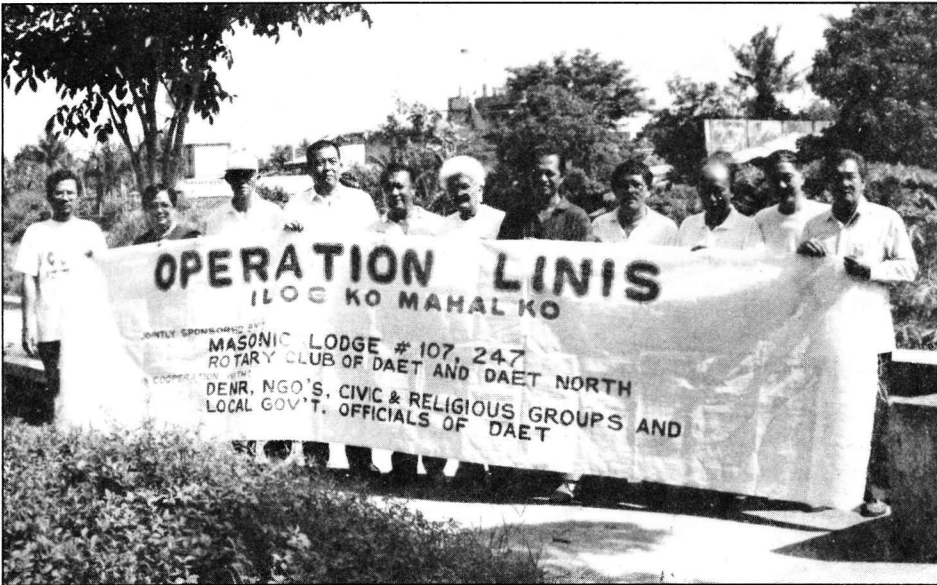
